**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO FILE OUT OF TIME**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed its files and records and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds as follows:

1.        On November 6, 2006, the Commission issued an order opening the above docket to investigate Section III of the Commission's Billing Standards as it relates to security deposits for residential and nonresidential customers.

2.        In the order opening the docket, the Commission made all Kansas jurisdictional gas, electric and water certificated public utilities parties to the investigation and required each party to file an entry of appearance if it wanted to participate in the docket.

3.        On December 15, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) filed a motion to File Out of Time and stated that it inadvertently did not make the additional entry of appearance filing by the deadline date. KCPL further stated that allowing KCPL to enter its appearance will not delay this proceeding or prejudice any party thereto.

4.        The Commission finds and concludes that KCPL's motion to File Out of Time should be granted.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. Kansas City Power & Light Company's Motion to File Out of Time shall be granted.

B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118; K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order or orders, as it may deem necessary


