PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CONTINUING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

- 1. On May 18, 2017, the Commission designated a Prehearing Officer to address any scheduling or procedural matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-517(b).
- 2. On June 8, 2017, at the Prehearing Conference, the parties agreed to continue the Prehearing Conference until July 6, 2017, to allow parties to file pleadings, objections and motions.¹
- 3. On July 6, 2017, a Prehearing Conference was held, wherein the parties indicated that discovery was in process, but requested an additional five weeks to complete discovery and allow parties file any desired pleadings, objections or motions.
- 4. On August 8, 2017, Agricultural Energy Services (AES) filed a Motion for Summary Judgment and Memorandum in Support.
- 5. On August 10, 2017, the parties held a Prehearing Conference, wherein Staff indicated its need to conduct further discovery to respond to AES's Motion for Summary Judgment. Staff asked for a sixty (60) day continuance of the Prehearing Conference to allow for adequate discovery and response time. AES had no objection to the continuance.

THEREFORE, THE PREHEARING OFFICER ORDERS:

A. The Prehearing Conference shall be rescheduled for Thursday, October 12, 2017,

at 9:30 a.m. by telephone. The conference call information is: telephone number: (866) 620-7326,

B. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing

testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

C. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be

converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as

provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA).² Any party that fails to attend or

participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in

default pursuant to the KAPA.³

A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁴ D.

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for

reconsideration.⁵

F. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
