ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

- 1. On August 13, 2018, Richlan Drilling (Operator) filed an Application seeking an exception to the 10-year time limitation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 for the Schneweis #9 well in Barton County, Kansas.¹
- 2. On October 2, 2018, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion for the Designation of a Prehearing Officer and the Scheduling of a Prehearing Conference (Motion).²
- 3. On October 9, 2018, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, scheduling a Prehearing Conference for October 25, 2018.³

4. A Prehearing Conference was held on October 25, 2018, at which the following procedural schedule was proposed:

- 5. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit the parties' direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.
- 6. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by December 3, 2018.
- 7. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.
- 8. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or in any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.⁴
- 9. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁵
