MOTION FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Mid-Kansas Electric Company, LLC (Mid-Kansas), hereby moves the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission or KCC) to establish a procedural schedule in this matter. In support of its motion, Mid-Kansas states:

1. Concurrently with the filing of this Motion, Mid-Kansas, on behalf of its member Southern Pioneer Electric Company (Southern Pioneer), filed with the Commission an Application, with supporting testimony and schedules, seeking approval to make certain changes to its charges for electric service in the geographical service territory served by Southern Pioneer.

2. In Docket No. 12-MKEE-380-RTS (“the 380 Docket”), the last general rate proceeding on behalf of Southern Pioneer, Mid-Kansas sought and received Commission approval to file the Application pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-231(b)(3)(A), which is the regulation governing the Commission’s “abbreviated” rate case filings. As part of the Settlement Agreement approved in the 380 Docket, the Commission also approved a procedural timeline of 180-days for the abbreviated rate case filing.¹


3. Based on these facts Mid-Kansas has developed for Commission consideration the proposed schedule set forth below.
