## ORDER ADOPTING STAFF REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined Staff's Report and Recommendation submitted in this matter and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On March 23, 2017, Donald and Dottie Murphy (Complainants) filed a Formal Complaint against Westar Energy, Inc. (Westar) with the Commission. Complainants alleged that they were entitled to a refund from Westar for improper charges for electric service to their barn which had been incorrectly billed on a commercial rate schedule instead of a residential rate schedule. Complainants sought reimbursement for the difference between the commercial and residential rates for electric service to their barn from 2005 through March 2017.
- 2. On April 26, 2017, Litigation Staff analyzed the Formal Complaint and recommended that the Complaint substantially complied with K.A.R. 82-1-220 and should be served upon Westar for an Answer.<sup>3</sup>

- 3. On May 2, 2017, the Commission entered an Order Adopting Staff's Legal Memorandum finding that, "Westar shall be served a true copy of the Formal Complaint, and Westar shall either satisfy the matter complained of or file a written answer within 10 days."
- 4. On May 15, 2017, Westar filed an Answer to the Complaint asserting, among other things, that it had not violated any provision of its Tariff and requested that the Commission deny the Complaint and for such other and further relief as may be appropriate.<sup>5</sup>
- 5. On September 6, 2017, Commission Staff filed its Report and Recommendation and agreed with Westar that "[a]lthough Section 2.04.01(b) of Westar's GT&C sets parameters for when Westar may reissue bills that were originally issued under an incorrect rate schedule, it does not require Westar to reissue such bills. Nevertheless, Westar has reissued the maximum number of the Complainants' bills allowed by its GT&C. Therefore, Staff recommends the Commission find Westar's reissuance of bills to be appropriate compensation for the Complainants." Staff further recommended the Commission find Westar appropriately followed its policy regarding choice of rate schedules, not require any further action of Westar and recommended dismissal of the Complaint.
- 6. Upon review of the record as a whole, the Commission agrees with Staff's analysis and recommendation to dismiss the Complaint. The Commission finds that Westar has complied with its tariff and appropriately followed its policy regarding choice of rate schedules.
  - 7. Based on the foregoing, the Complainants' Complaint is dismissed.
