## MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT/OPPOSITION OF SETTLEMENT

Kansas Gas Service, a division of ONE Gas, Inc. ("Kansas Gas Service"), moves for an order from the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission") approving an extension of time to file a Settlement Agreement and Testimony in Support/Opposition of a Settlement Agreement in the above-captioned docket. In support of its motion, Kansas Gas Service states as follows:

1. On September 5, 2023, Kansas Gas Service filed an application, supporting testimony and associated exhibits pursuant to K.S.A. 66-101, *et seq.*, 66-104, 66-117, 66-131, 66-136, 66-1,200 *et seq.*, and other applicable statutes, requesting approval by the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission" or "KCC") of a transaction whereby Kansas Gas Service acquires certain assets of Southern Star pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in an Asset Purchase Agreement dated December 16, 2022 ("APA"). The assets include meters and other facilities that Southern Star currently uses to provide service to domestic customers mostly pursuant to provisions of right-of-way easements. Southern Star has been engaged in an ongoing effort to eliminate ownership and operation of domestic meters on its system by transferring the meters and facilities to qualified local distribution companies. This will allow Southern Star to focus on operating its interstate transmission system while ensuring affected customers continue to receive safe and reliable service from a qualified

operator.

2. The Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board ("CURB"), the Kansas Municipal Gas Agency

("KMGA"), and Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline, Inc. ("Southern Star") were all granted

permission to intervene in this docket.

3. The parties began settlement discussions on May 23, 2024, in accordance with the

Procedural Schedule adopted by the Commission on January 16, 2024 ("Procedural Order").

4. Pursuant to the Procedural Order, the settlement agreement was to be filed on or before

June 3, 2024.

5. Because the parties are still in settlement discussions, Kansas Gas Service is requesting

the Commission issue an order approving an extension of the June 3, 2024 date on which to file a

settlement agreement to June 10, 2024, and an extension of the June 10, 2024 date on which to file

testimony on the settlement agreement to June 17, 2024. None of the parties oppose this extension.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth herein, Kansas Gas Service requests that its motion

for extension of time to file a settlement agreement and testimony in support/opposition of the

settlement agreement be granted.
