ORDER CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On October 11, 2016, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, ordering Operator to pay a \$1,000 penalty and plug its Big Basin #3 well.¹
 - On November 7, 2016, Operator filed its request for a hearing in this matter. 2.
- 3. On December 13, 2016, the Commission issued its Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference, wherein the Commission scheduled a Prehearing Conference in this matter for December 22, 2016.
- 4. On December 19, 2016, Operator informed Commission Staff Litigation Counsel by letter that it "no longer has a KS attorney and is withdrawing the hearing request for the Big Basin #3 well." Operator has also paid the \$1,000 penalty ordered in the aforementioned Penalty Order.³ and Staff has confirmed that the Big Basin #3 well has been plugged.

5. Based on Operator's compliance with the Commission's Penalty Order in this docket, the Commission finds this matter is appropriately resolved, and the docket should be closed.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. The Prehearing Conference scheduled for December 22, 2016, is cancelled, and the docket is closed.
- B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if mailed service, from the date this Order was served in which to petition for reconsideration.⁴
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
