

**MOTION TO CANCEL PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND CLOSE DOCKET**

On October 18, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting that an order to show cause be issued against Operator, based upon Commission records indicating that unplugged wells remained on Operator's expired license. On January 12, 2017, the Commission issued an order to show cause, setting a February 9, 2017, prehearing conference.

Staff has recently determined that Mr. Williams is deceased. Therefore, pursuit of this matter would not be useful. All remaining issues can be addressed by Staff administratively. Staff thus asks that the prehearing conference be cancelled and that the docket be closed.

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
