ORDER APPROVING NAME CHANGE

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and record, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On October 4, 2018, Time Warner Cable Midwest, LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable (Time Warner Cable) filed an Application requesting authority to change the name on its Video Service Authorization from Time Warner Cable Midwest LLC to Spectrum Mid-America, LLC (Spectrum). Time Warner Cable previously received authority to provide Video Service in the State of Kansas on October 5, 2012, in an Order granting Video Service Authorization in Docket No. 13-TWMC-206-VSA (Docket 13-206). Spectrum is registered with the Secretary of State and the name change is on file with that office. Spectrum is an active business organization conducting business as a limited liability company and currently maintains a “Good Standing” designation.

2. The Commission derives its authority to review Video Service from K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 12-2023. Regarding the request for a company name change, Spectrum, in accordance with K.A.R. 82-15-1 (e), must give notice of a name change within 14 business days after the effective date of the change.

3. On October 25, 2018, the Commission Staff (Staff) submitted a Report and Recommendation, dated October 24, 2018, recommending the Commission grant the Time Warner Cable Application and approve the requested name change to Spectrum on the Video Service Authorization previously granted in Docket 13-206.

4. The Commission adopts Staff's analysis and recommendations of October 24, 2018, as stated in the Report and Recommendation, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, and finds that the Time Warner Cable Application should be granted. The Commission further finds that the requested name change to Spectrum under the Time Warner Video Service Authorization should be approved. As part of the approval process, the Commission directs Spectrum to notify it regarding any change in address or contact telephone numbers in a timely manner.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The Time Warner Cable Midwest LLC's Application filed in this matter on October 4, 2018, is hereby granted and the request for a name change to Spectrum Mid-America, LLC, under its Video Service Authorization issued in Docket No. 13-TWMC-260-VSA is hereby granted.

B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529 (a) (1).¹

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On October 4, 2018, Time Warner Cable Midwest LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable (Time Warner Cable) filed an Application requesting the Commission change its name on its Video Service Authorization to Spectrum Mid-America, LLC. Staff recommends approval of this Application.

BACKGROUND:

K.S.A. 12-2023 gives the Commission the authority to review applications for those entities who desire to provide cable service or video service in the state of Kansas.

K.A.R. 82-15-1.(e) states: "Each entity holding a video service authorization certificate shall provide notice of any change in the name of the entity, contact personnel, mailing address, and phone number by sending a notification letter specifying the number of the docket in which the certificate was granted. The notice shall be provided within 14 business days after the effective date of the change."

ANALYSIS:

Time Warner Cable requests that the name on its Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide Video Service Authorization within the state of Kansas be changed to Spectrum Mid-America, LLC. The Company states there was no change of control of the VSA holder or transfer of the VSA. Time Warner Cable was issued a Video Service Authorization in Docket No. 13-TWMC-206-VSA on October 5, 2012.

Spectrum Mid-America, LLC is properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office and authorized to engage in business in Kansas. They are currently "active and in good standing" with the Secretary's Office.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Time Warner Cable's Application to change the name on its Video Service Authorization.
