ORDER GRANTING AMENDED VIDEO SERVICE AUTHORIZATION TO INCLUDE THE CITY OF RILEY

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

On August 28, 2012 Eagle Communications, Inc. ("Eagle") filed an Amended 1. Application for a state-issued Video Service Authorization, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-2023 and K.A.R. 82-15-1. Eagle currently holds a Video Service Authorization that includes four service areas.

2. Eagle's filing seeks to add an additional service area to its Video Service Authorization. Specifically, Eagle wishes to serve the City of Riley, Kansas.

3. K.S.A. 12-2023 states that the Commission shall issue a video service authorization permitting a video service provider to provide video service in the state, or amend a video service authorization previously issued, within 30 days after receipt of a completed affidavit submitted by the video service applicant and signed by an officer or general partner of the applicant affirming:

(1) The location of the applicant's principal place of business and the names of the applicant's principal executive officers;

(2) that the applicant has filed or will timely file with the federal communications commission all forms required by that agency in advance of offering video service in this state;

(3) that the applicant agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state statutes and regulations;

(4) that the applicant agrees to comply with all lawful and applicable municipal regulations regarding the use and occupation of public rights-of-way in the delivery of the video service, including the police powers of the municipalities in which the service is delivered;

(5) the description of the service area footprint to be served within the state of Kansas, including any municipalities or parts thereof, and which may include certain designations of unincorporated areas, which description shall be updated by the applicant prior to the expansion of video service to a previously undesignated service area and, upon such expansion, notice to the state corporation commission of the service area to be served by the applicant; including:

(A) The period of time it shall take applicant to become capable of providing video programming to all households in the applicant's service area footprint, which may not exceed five years from the date the authorization, or amended authorization, is issued; and

(B) a general description of the type or types of technologies the applicant will use to provide video programming to all households in its service area footprint, which may include wireline, wireless, satellite or any other alternative technology.

3. Commission Staff ("Staff") submitted a Report and Recommendation regarding the application for an amended authorization on September 6, 2012, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference. Staff found that Eagle is properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office, and its principal place of business is 2703 Hall Street, Ste. 15, Hays, Kansas. (*See* K.S.A. 12-2023(a)(1)). Staff verified that Eagle is properly registered with the Federal Communications Commission regarding the Community Unit Identification Number ("CUID") for the City of Riley, Kansas. (*See* K.S.A. 12-2023(a)(2)). Staff found that Eagle agreed to follow all applicable federal, state, and municipal rules and regulations. (*See* K.S.A. 12-2023(a)(3)-(4)). Finally, Staff found that Eagle states it currently passes 100% of households encompassed in the proposed service area. (*See* K.S.A. 12-2023(a)(5)(A)). For ease of future reference, Staff is identifying the proposed service area as follows: The City of Riley, RILY-05-EAGC-01.

4. Staff recommended approval of the amended Video Service Authorization.

5. The Commission finds Staff's findings to be reasonable and hereby adopts Staff's recommendation of approving the amended Video Service Authorization.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. The amended application filed by Eagle on August 28, 2012 for a Video Service Authorization is approved.

B. Eagle is granted authority to provide video service as requested in the application.
The grant of authority is subject to lawful operation of the video service by the applicant or its successor in interest.

C. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).

D. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.

BY THE COMMISSION IT IS SO ORDERED.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On August 28, 2012, Eagle Communications, Inc. (Eagle) filed an Amended Application for state-issued Video Service Authorization, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-2023 and K.A.R. 82-15-1. Staff recommends approval of this Application.

BACKGROUND:

The Applicant has previously been granted state-issued video service authorizations in four service areas (footprints). This amended filing seeks additional authority, specifically the City of Riley, Kansas.

Per K.S.A. 12-2023(a), Commission action in this matter is required not later than **Thursday**, **September 27, 2012.**

ANALYSIS:

The Applicant has identified its principal place of business as 2703 Hall Street, Ste. 15, Hays, Kansas.



The Applicant is properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's office as a Kansas For Profit Corporation. Its current status with the Secretary's office is Active and in Good Standing.

The Applicant states they are properly registered with the FCC for their proposed service areas and provided the following Community Unit Identification (CUID) information:

Staff has verified the above Community Unit Identification Numbers (CUID) via the FCC's Media Bureau's website <u>http://transition.fcc.gov/mb/engineering/liststate.html</u>.

By initialing, the Applicant has previously¹ agreed to comply with all applicable federal and state statutes and regulations and agrees to comply with all lawful and applicable municipal regulations regarding the use and occupation of public rights-of-way in the delivery of video services, including the police powers of the municipalities in which the service is delivered. (Application item #5).

The Application includes a three (3) page "Meets and Bounds" description of the service area. That description is on file with the Commission in this docket and has been provided electronically in a format compatible with the Commission's mapping system. The Company states that it currently passes 100% of the households encompassed in that area.

For ease of future reference, Staff is identitying² the proposed service area footprint, as follows: The City of Riley, RILY-05-EAGC-01.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Commission approval of Eagle's Application with its additional service area footprint to be identified and known as Riley, RILY-05-EAGC-01.

^{2.} For ease of future referencing, staff assigns a four field footprint number using the following convention: ABCD-xx-EFGHyy, where ABCD is the four character abbreviation of the major city encompassed by the service area, xx is a two digit sequentially assigned number of the provider's service areas, EFGH is the four alpha character company code and yy indicating the version of the company's footprint where 01 is the initial version, 02 the first revision, etc.
