ORDER GRANTING CURB'S PETITION TO INTERVENE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions:

- 1. On April 26, 2017, Southern Pioneer Electric Company (Southern Pioneer) filed an Application to change its retail rates and wholesale Local Access Delivery Service (LADS) demand rate in its annual update of: (1) the Debt Service Coverage Formula Based Ratemaking Pilot Program (DSC-FBR) and (2) the 34.5 kV Formula Based Ratemaking Plan. ¹
- 2. On May 3, 2017, the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB) filed its Petition to Intervene and Motion for Protective Order and Discovery Order in this docket, citing its statutory authority to represent the interests of Kansas residential and small commercial ratepayers in any utility proceeding before the Commission and to function as an official intervenor in cases filed with the Commission pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1223 and K.S.A. 77-

521(a). CURB requests intervention because the rates paid and the services received by Kansas residential and small commercial ratepayers may be substantially affected by any Commission order or activity in this proceeding.³

On May 2, 2017, the Commission issued its Suspension, Protective and Discovery 3. Order in this docket, thereby rendering CURB's Motion for Protective Order and Discovery Order moot.

4. The Commission has broad discretion to grant intervention if it serves the interests of justice, if it will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings, and if the party has stated facts demonstrating its legal rights, duties and privileges, immunities or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.⁴ Furthermore, at any time during a proceeding, the Commission may limit an intervenor's participation.⁵

5. The Commission finds that CURB has met the requirements of K.S.A. 77-521 and K.A.R. 82-1-225 and should be granted intervention in this docket. CURB will be added to the service list. - A. The Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board's Petition to Intervene is granted.
- B. The parties have fifteen (15) days from the date this Order was served by electronic mail in which to petition for reconsideration.⁶
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
