Dear Ms. Retz:

On November 2, 1998, Level 3 Communications, LLC ("Level 3") filed an application seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity to engage in the business of providing resold and facilities-based, switched and dedicated local exchange telecommunications services in non-rural areas in the State of Kansas, which was granted by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") on May 14, 1999.<sup>1</sup> The purpose of this letter is to advise the Commission that since the time Level 3 filed its application, the Company has implemented new service offerings that utilize IP technology. Further, expansion of its IP offerings include all areas of the State, including rural areas. As it now provides telecommunications services via VoIP technology, Level 3 is exempt under K.S.A. 66-2017 from all regulatory requirements, except for the requirements pertaining to the Kansas Universal Service Fund<sup>2</sup> and the Kansas 911 Act.<sup>3</sup>

Please note this letter is for informational purposes only. Level 3 is not seeking, nor does it want, to cancel its certificate issued in the above-reference docket.
