NOTICE OF PENALTY ASSESSMENT 20-TRAM-003-PEN

This is a notice of a penalty assessment against Paul Ramirez, d/b/a Ramirez Industries (Ramirez Industries) for violation(s) of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted on June 12, 2019, by Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator Gary Goeller. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2019 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on August 7, 2018. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY: Ramirez Industries has been assessed a \$1,500 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$1,500, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's KTRAN system located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

The attached Order requires a representative of Ramirez Industries to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order and to provide the undersigned Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of dates and locations for safety seminars can be found at the Commission's website http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety_meetings.htm. The Order also requires your company to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within 18 months from the date of the Order. Transportation Staff will contact your company at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.

IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing. A request for hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. Ramirez Industries must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel. K.A.R. 82-1-215; K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 77-542.

IF YOU FAIL TO ACT: Failure to pay the penalty of \$1,500 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

- 1. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-4-1b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112, 66-1,114, 66-1,114b and 66-1,115, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in K.A.R. 82-4-1, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.
- 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard

to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.

3. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

II. BACKGROUND

- 4. Paul Ramirez, d/b/a Ramirez Industries (Ramirez Industries) has common operating authority with the Commission and further operates under USDOT number 2484312.
- 5. Paul Ramirez attended the Procedures for Safety Compliance Seminar presented by the Kansas Corporation Commission, on June 4, 2019, on behalf of Ramirez Industries.
- 6. Ramirez Industries is a common motor carrier which primarily hauls general freight, US mail and paper products.

III. STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 7. Pursuant to the jurisdiction and authority cited above, on June 12, 2019, Commission Staff (Staff) Special Investigator Gary Goeller conducted a safety compliance review of the operations of Ramirez Industries. A copy of the safety compliance review is included in this Penalty Order as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the special investigator identified five (5) violation(s) of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.
 - a. On March 27, 2019, Ramirez Industries required or permitted its driver,
 Ross C. Armstrong, to operate a CDL-required commercial motor vehicle,
 a 2000 Volvo, VIN ending in 794733, GVWR 32,000 lbs., pulling a 2001

WANC trailer, VIN ending in 75677, GVWR 68,000 lbs., in intrastate commerce from Wichita, Kansas to Kansas City, Kansas. This trip is Driver/Vehicle evidenced Examination Report Number by KSHP00320244, dated March 27, 2019, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "B" and is hereby incorporated by reference. At the time of this transportation, Ramirez Industries had not implemented an alcohol and controlled substance testing program for its CDL driver. The carrier's failure to establish an alcohol and controlled substances testing program for its CDL drivers that complies with the procedures established in 49 C.F.R. 382.105 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c is a violation of 49 C.F.R. 382.115(a), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c, and authorized by K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,129. Staff recommends a fine of \$350.

b. On May 8, 2019, Ramirez Industries required or permitted its driver, Ross C. Armstrong, to operate a CDL-required commercial motor vehicle, a 2000 Volvo, VIN ending in 794733, GVWR 32,000 lbs., pulling a 2001 WANC trailer, VIN ending in 75677, GVWR 68,000 lbs., in interstate commerce from Wichita, Kansas to Kansas City, Missouri. This trip is evidenced by Driver's Daily Log, dated May 8, 2019, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "C" and is hereby incorporated by reference. At the time of this transportation, Ramirez Industries had not paid its Uniform Carrier Registration (UCR) fees for 2019. The carrier's failure to annually register its commercial motor vehicle(s) operating in interstate commerce over the highways of this state and to pay the

- appropriate Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees as set out in 49 C.F.R. 367.30, is a violation of K.A.R. 82-4-30a, authorized by K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,139a and K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,129. Staff recommends a fine of \$300.
- c. During the transportation described in paragraph a, above, Ramirez Industries used a driver that was not medically examined and certified as physically fit to operate a commercial motor vehicle during the preceding 24 months. The carrier's failure to confirm that its CDL driver is medically examined and certified prior to requiring or permitting the operation of a commercial motor vehicle and maintaining documentation of the medical certificate in the driver qualification file is a violation of 49 C.F.R. 391.41(a)(1)(i), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3g, and authorized by K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,129. Staff recommends a fine of \$250.
- d. On February 13, 2019, Ramirez Industries required or permitted its driver, Victoria Ramirez, to operation a commercial motor vehicle, a 2012 GMC, VIN ending in 1905851, GVWR 12,300 lbs., in interstate commerce from Blackwell, Oklahoma to Wichita, Kansas. This trip is evidenced by Driver/Vehicle Examination Report Number KSKC82040128, dated February 13, 2019, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "D" and is hereby incorporated by reference. At the time of this transportation, Ramirez Industries failed to maintain a road test certificate in the driver's qualification file, or copy of the license or certificate the motor carrier accepted as equivalent. The carrier's failure to maintain a road test

certificate issued to the driver pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 391.3(e) in the driver's qualification file, or a copy of the license or certificate which the motor carrier accepted as equivalent to the driver's road test pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 391.33 is a violation of 49 C.F.R. 391.51(b)(3), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3g, and authorized by K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,129. Staff recommends a fine of \$100.

e. During the transportation described in paragraph d, above, Ramirez Industries did not have state of Kansas for-hire motor carrier authority. The carrier's commercial operations of motor vehicles prior to obtaining and maintaining proper Commission authority is a violation of K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,111 and 49 C.F.R. 392.2, adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3h, and authorized by K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,129. Staff recommends a fine of \$500.

IV. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATIONS

- 8. Based upon the available facts, Staff recommends the Commission finds Ramirez Industries committed five (5) violation(s) of Kansas law that governs motor carriers, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations, and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.
- 9. Additionally, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$1,500 for five (5) violation(s) of the Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations.
- 10. Staff further recommends that a representative from Ramirez Industries be required to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date

of this Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety_meetings.htm.

11. Finally, Staff recommends that Ramirez Industries submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.

V. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 12. The Commission finds it has jurisdiction over Ramirez Industries because it is a motor carrier as defined in K.A.R. 82-4-1.
- 13. The Commission finds Ramirez Industries committed five (5) violation(s) of Kansas law that governs motor carriers, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations, and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- A. Paul Ramirez, d/b/a Ramirez Industries, of Wichita, KS is hereby assessed a \$1,500 civil penalty for five (5) violation(s) of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.
- B. Ramirez Industries is hereby ordered to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and is to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.

- C. Ramirez Industries is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the carrier to set up the appointment.
- D. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director, at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Ramirez Industries' right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order assessing a \$1,500 civil penalty against Ramirez Industries, and ordering a representative from Ramirez Industries to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance, and to submit to a safety compliance review within 18 months from the date of this Order.
- E. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is in the public interest. K.S.A. 77-515(c); K.A.R. 82-1-228(d)(2); K.A.R. 82-1-202(a). For civil

penalties less than \$500, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the

corporation. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 66-1,142b(e) and amendments thereto.

F. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$1,500 is due

in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$1,500 must be made

through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's KTRAN system

located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the

penalty.

G. Failure to pay the \$1,500 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of

service of this Penalty Order, see K.S.A. 66-1,105, and/or failure to comply with the provisions

of this Order, may result in suspension of Ramirez Industries' motor carrier operating authority

without further notice. Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include,

but not limited to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and

desist orders, and any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.

H. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders, as necessary.



Document and Follow Through on Action Plans: Document and follow through on action plans to ensure

the actions you are taking are creating improvement in safety management and compliance.

NOTICE: A pattern and/or repeated violations of the same or related acute or critical regulations (violations of the same Part in Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations) will cause the maximum penalties allowed by law to be assessed under Section 222 of the Motor Carrier Safety Improvement Act of 1999 (MCSIA). A pattern of violations means two or more violations of acute and/or critical regulations in three or more Parts of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations discovered during any eligible investigation. Repeated violations means violation(s) of an acute regulation of the same Part of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations discovered in an investigation after one or more closed enforcement actions within a six year period and/or violation(s) of a critical regulation in the same Part of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations discovered in an investigation after two or more closed enforcement actions within a six year period.

NOTICE: 49 CFR Part 391.23 requires prospective employers to, at a minimum, investigate a driver's employment information, crash record, and alcohol and controlled substances history from all employers the driver

worked for within the previous 3 years.

The Pre-Employment Screening Program (PSP) is a screening tool that assists motor carriers in investigating crash history and roadside safety performance of prospective drivers. The PSP allows motor carriers to purchase 5 years of crash data and 3 years of roadside inspection data from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's (FMCSA) Motor Carrier Management Information System (MCMIS). Records are available 24 hours a day via Web request. Motor carriers should visit the following website for more information: http://www.psp.fmcsa.dot.gov/Pages/default.aspx

• All motor carriers and truck drivers are needed to fight against terrorism and hijacking. You could be a target. Protect yourself, your trucks, your cargo, and your facilities. FMCSA recently announced planned improvements to the Carrier Safety Measurement System (SMS) which was implemented in December 2010 as part of the Agency's broader Compliance, Safety, Accountability (CSA) initiative. A preview of these improvements is currently available to motor carriers. The system changes are scheduled to be available to the public in July 2012. There will be additional opportunity for public comment on the changes after the preview period ends in July 2012. The improvements to SMS are based on ongoing analysis and feedback from enforcement personnel, the motor carrier industry, and other stakeholders. The changes more effectively identify and prioritize high-risk and other unsafe motor carriers for enforcement interventions designed to reduce commercial motor vehicle crashes and hazardous materials incidents. Motor carrier's currently have the ability to preview how the improvements impact their individual safety data in SMS. These improvements include: (1) Changes to the SMS methodology that identify higher risk carriers while addressing industry biases, (2) better applications of SMS results for Agency interventions by more accurately identifying safety sensitive carriers (i.e., carriers transporting people and carriers hauling hazardous materials (HM)), so that such firms can be selected for CSA interventions at more stringent levels; and, (3) more specific fact-based displays of SMS results on the SMS Web site. The data preview may be found at http://csa.fmcsa dot.gov/. During the data preview period, the Agency requests comments on the impacts of the changes.

This letter should be submitted as soon as possible.

For all Investigations that did not result in a Cooperative Safety Plan:

The KCC requires that you prepare a corrective action letter plan (CAP), addressing the measures taken to correct all violations identified within this report. Submit this letter within 30 days outlining the carrier's updated changes to their policies and procedures regarding all listed violations. Explain in detail how, as a carrier representative, you will rectify these deficiencies and prevent their reoccurrence going forward. Include any supporting documentation and evidence as indicated in the recommendations above, (example: vehicle inspections performed, proof of drug
