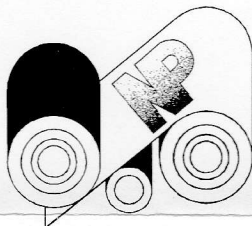

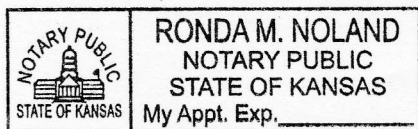

TO: All oil and gas offsetting operators, lease holders and unleased mineral owners, and all persons concerned.

You and each of you are hereby notified that Lynn Packard Operating Company has filed an Application with the Kansas Corporation Commission (Commission) requesting an order granting an exception from the pit closure time limitation of K.A.R. 82 3 602 at the Packard 1-15 reserve pit in Section 15, Township 31 south, Range 13 west, Barber County, Kansas.

Any persons who object to or protest this Application shall be required to file their objections of protests in writing with the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within fifteen (15) days from the date of this publication. If a written notice is not timely filed, the Application may be determined administratively by the Commission and may thereby be granted without hearing or further notice to any interested party. All objections and protests shall clearly state the reasons why granting the Application will cause waste or threaten fresh and usable water. Objections or protests shall be mailed to the Kansas Corporation Commission, Conservation Division, 266 North Main Street, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas, 67202 with a copy to the applicant listed below.
