MOTION FOR SHUT-IN ORDER

The Staff of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively), moves the Commission for a Shut-in Order to be issued against the Operator. In support of its motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. On August 09, 2018, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket finding the Operator committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-409.
- 2. The Penalty Order gave the Operator 30 days to pay a \$100 penalty and to file the required annual fluid injection report.² The Penalty Order stated that if the Operator failed to comply, then the Operator's license would be suspended without further notice.³
 - 3. On August 16, 2018, the Operator requested a hearing.
- 4. On September 6, 2018, the Commission issued its Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference, scheduling a prehearing conference for October 11, 2018.⁴
- 5. On October 19, 2018, Staff filed a Motion for Default Order, stating, "Staff believes Operator was properly noticed and afforded the opportunity to attend and participate in

the October 11, 2018, prehearing conference, but failed to do so. Therefore, Staff requests that a default order be issued against Operator."⁵

- 6. On October 30, 2018, the Commission issued a Default Order against the Operator. The same day, the Operator filed an appeal of the Default Order, citing Kerry Patrick's "serious health problems". ⁶
- 7. On November 29, 2018, the Commission issued an Order on Appeal of Default Order, in which the Commission vacated its October 30, 2018, Default Order and scheduled a January 10, 2019, prehearing conference.⁷
- 8. On January 10, 2019, a Prehearing Conference was held. Staff appeared at the Prehearing Conference, but the Operator did not.
- 9. On January 16, 2019, Staff filed its second Motion for Default Order in this docket, stating, "Staff believes Operator was properly noticed and afforded the opportunity to participate in the January 10, 2019, prehearing conference, but failed to do so. This is the second prehearing conference the Operator has failed to attend. Therefore, Staff requests that a default order be issued against the Operator."
- 10. On February 5, 2019, the Commission issued a Second Default Order against the Operator.
- 11. On February 20, 2019, Staff suspended the Operator's license for non-compliance with a Commission Order. Staff sent a Notice of License Suspension to the Operator, stating that the Operator was in violation of a Commission Order. Staff's letter stated that if, after 10 days,

Staff discovered the Operator performing oil and gas operations, Staff would recommend a Shut-In Order, including an additional \$10,000 penalty.⁹

12. On February 27, 2019, the Operator paid the \$100 penalty associated with the Penalty Order in this docket but the Operator has failed to file the required annual fluid injection report. Therefore, the Operator's license remains suspended for failure to comply with a Commission Order.

13. On March 8, 2019 and March 11, 2019, Commission Staff conducted lease inspections and found multiple wells on the Operator's leases to be in operation. Staff took pictures of the Bodley #5, Earl Gray #48, Hempen #6, Pugh-Hamman #4, S. Earl Grey PDC #3, and the S. Earl Grey PDC#5 wells' pump jack in motion in clear violation of the Operator's license suspension.¹⁰

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Staff respectfully requests the Commission issue a Shut-in Order against Operator assessing the Operator an additional \$2,500 penalty and directing Staff to shut-in and seal all of the Operator's oil and gas operations until the Operator complies with the Commission's Penalty Order in this docket.
