I, Gregory L. Brown, of lawful age, duly sworn, do state the following:

I am the General Manager of Jayhawk Pipeline, L.L.C.

This Affidavit is being provided as a supplement to Jayhawk Pipeline, L.LC.'s Application to Cease Operation of certain routes as shown on Supplement No. 17 to KCC No. 80, Supplement No. 15 to KCC No. 81 and Supplement No. 14 to KCC No. 82, with an effective date of January 1, 2019.

The Chase to Valley Center line segment originates at Chase Station in Rice County, Kansas with an intermediate injection point at Burrton Station. It is utilized by CHS McPherson Refinery Inc. ("CHS"), Coffeyville Resources, and MV Purchasing with a destination at Valley Center (Sedgwick County), Kansas.

The 65.8-mile Chase to Valley Center pipeline system was assessed with an In-line Inspection tool for integrity, anomalies identified, and the estimated cost of repair and risks to the environment is determined too great to justify repairing the system.

Jayhawk proposes to cancel all routes and corresponding rates on Supplement No. 17 to KCC No. 80 which are delivered to Valley Center Station in Sedgwick County, Kansas.

CHS will move their volumes previously sent to Valley Center to McPherson Station (found on Supplement No. 17 to KCC 80). Their needs are expected to be met by this facility.

Coffeyville Resources began moving Valley Center volumes to a new truck unloading facility owned by Pony Express Pipeline near Natoma (Rooks County), Kansas in March 2018. Their remaining volumes will be delivered to Hudson, McPherson (found on Supplement No. 17 to KCC 80), or to their own facilities. Their needs are expected to be met by these facilities.

MV Purchasing will move Valley Center volumes to Hudson or McPherson (found on Supplement No. 17 to KCC 80), or to other pipeline systems where they own existing unloading facilities. Their needs are expected to be met by these facilities.

All other services and rates offered on Supplement No. 17 to KCC 80 will remain unchanged.

Jayhawk proposes to cancel all routes and corresponding rates on Supplement No. 15 to KCC No. 81 which are received at or delivered to Valley Center Station in Sedgwick County, Kansas.

CHS will move Valley Center and Burrton volumes to current Jayhawk unloading facilities at Valley Center, or by truck to an unloading facility at McPherson Station (found on Supplement No. 15 to KCC 81). Their needs are expected to be met by these facilities.

Coffeyville Resources began moving Valley Center volumes to a new truck unloading facility owned by Pony Express Pipeline near Natoma (Rooks County), Kansas in March 2018. Their remaining volumes will be delivered to current unloading Jayhawk facilities at Valley Center. (found on Supplement No. 15 to KCC 81), or to their own facilities at Valley Center. Their needs are expected to be met by these facilities.

The truck unloading services and associated rate at Valley Center and McPherson remains unchanged. The truck unloading service at Valley Center will remain open until April or May of 2019.

Jayhawk proposes to cancel the route and corresponding rate on Supplement No. 14 to KCC No. 82 which is received at Valley Center Station in Sedgwick County, Kansas.

Coffeyville Resources and MV Purchasing volumes will be delivered to McPherson (found on Supplement No. 14 to KCC 82), or to their own facilities. Their needs are expected to be met by these facilities.

The service and associated rate from Hudson Station to McPherson Station will remain unchanged. The truck unloading service and associated rate will remain unchanged.

If approved, this cessation would be effective January 1, 2019.


