Dear Rene Stucky:

I would like to protest and request a hearing in the matter of Palomino Petroleum's application for injection authority into the Carter Trust SWD #1, located at 1105' FSL & 1192' FWL in Sec. 23-17S-26W, Ness County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure of 0# and a maximum injection rate of 8,000 bbls. per day.

As a Kansas homeowner who home has been shaken repeatedly by earthquakes that the Kansas Geological Survey and KCC commissioners in orders restricting injection volumes in affected areas have acknowledged are caused by injection activity, I am directly impacted by induced seismicity. I fear the induced seismicity that can reasonably be expected to occur if this large volume well is permitted could damage my home and my water supply, which comes from a small municipal water well. I also have grave concerned that repeated earthquakes of even small magnitudes threaten the integrity of underground cement well casings, which could cause toxic fluids to migrate and threaten water.

Thank you for allowing me as a citizen to participate in the regulatory process as is required by the Safe Water Drinking Act.
