SUSPENSION ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

- 1. On November 22, 2011, Howison Heights, Inc., ("Howison") filed an Application with the Commission for approval of its certain changes in charges for water service.
- 2. A full investigation of the Application, which may result in a hearing, is deemed necessary and proper. Commission staff is without sufficient time to fully review, consider and analyze whether the proposed programs are just and reasonable.
- 3. The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of the Application and deferral of its effective date are required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter. The Commission may suspend an application for up to 240 days from the date of the application pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c).
- 4. The Commission finds and concludes this Application should be suspended for a period of 180 days from the date the Application was made, November 22, 2011, until May 20, 2012, pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c). Should additional time be necessary for further investigation of the matter, the Commission reserves the right to enter further order or orders to suspend the

application for the full 240 days from the date the application was made. IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c), the Application in the above-captioned docket shall be suspended and the effective date deferred until May 20, 2012.

B. The parties have 15 days, plus three days if service of this Order is by mail, from the date of service of this Order in which to request rehearing on any matter decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b, K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
