ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION TO VACATE PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. JURISDICTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,111, 66-1,112, and 66-1,114b, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in K.A.R. 82-4-3f as adopted in K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority, and jurisdiction.
- 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130, and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke, or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision, or regulation of the Commission.

II. FINDINGS OF FACTS

- 3. Waste Link Inc (Waste Link or Carrier) is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, which operated commercial motor vehicles in interstate commerce under the USDOT Number 2332332.
- 4. On July 9, 2021, Commission Staff (Staff) UCR Manager Verna Jackson submitted a Report and Recommendation regarding Carrier's failure to pay its UCR fees for year 2020.
- 5. On July 15, 2021, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket assessing a \$300 civil penalty against Carrier for failure to pay its 2020 UCR fees.
- 6. On July 21, 2021, Jim Rennycuff, Safety Director of Waste Link Inc, contacted Staff stating Carrier was sold to another company and requested deactivation of its USDOT profile. Staff agreed to deactivate Carrier's USDOT profile.
- 7. On July 30, 2021, Transportation Staff filed its Motion to Vacate Penalty Order recommending the Commission vacate the Penalty Order issued on July 15, 2021.

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 8. The Commission finds it has jurisdiction over Waste Link Inc because Carrier is a motor carrier, as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f.
- 9. The Commission further finds that Carrier was not in operation and that Staff has deactivated Carrier's USDOT profile.
- 10. Therefore the Commission concludes it is appropriate to vacate the Penalty Order issued July 15, 2021

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- A. The Penalty Order issued to Waste Link Inc on July 15, 2021, is hereby vacated.
- B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹
