## **NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and files this Notice of Compliance with the August 8, 2012 Order of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission"), issued in the above-captioned docket ("August 8 Order").<sup>1</sup> As of October 1, 2012, the 63 wind generating turbines at the Spearville 3 Wind Generating Facility located in Ford County, Kansas ("Spearville 3") were confirmed commercially in-service. This in-service event places KCP&L in compliance with the Commission's grant of a waiver from penalties under the Renewable Energy Standards Act ("RES Act") for 2012, where such waiver was conditioned upon KCP&L attaining sufficient renewable capacity in service prior to December 31, 2012. Consistent with KCP&L's Application in this docket, KCP&L now has sufficient renewable generating capacity in service and under contract to meet the RES Act requirements for 2012. As evidenced by the compliance data set forth in Tables 1 and 2 below,<sup>2</sup> which include the generating capacity of Spearville 3, KCP&L now has a total of 380.5 MW of renewable generation capacity of which an estimated 180.0 MW is allocated to the Kansas jurisdiction, exceeding its 2012 RES Act requirement of 167.2 MW.<sup>3</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> KCP&L executed a 10-year PPA with Central Nebraska Public Power Irrigation District ("CNPPID") for up to 63 MW of hydro power beginning January 1, 2014.<sup>4</sup> The three hydro facilities identified in the agreement, Jeffrey, Johnson No. 1 ("J-1") and Johnson No. 2 ("J-2"), are located along the CNPPID's irrigation supply canal located in Nebraska. These facilities are operational but currently are contracted to another party. KCP&L's 10year PPA with CNPPID for this hydro capacity begins January 1, 2014.
