It is my understanding from correspondence sent to me by the property owned that Houlds, that they have filed the proper paperwork with your agency. I recognize that the property owner has the right to drill wells on his property, but I am very concerned about the long and short reim environmental impacts that this activity will have on my property. In particular Lam very concerned about the impact that this drilling and use of salt water will have on my water well. One of the wells that has been dished is less than 25 yards from my only water source. Fown 200 plus acres of land and have been on this land since 1961 earning my living from cattle ranching and row crop farming, the water were is my traily source of water for not only me but the cattle and any future crops. My property is only separated from all of this activity by an unpaved county gravel road.

My nephew talked with a representative of the KCC last week in Chanute and was verbally assured that the concrete casing would prevent damage to the groundwater sources. This assumes that the parties doing the drilling comply with the required procedures. Without a representative or the aperty in physically review this site we are concerned that leakage might indeed occur. Without some inspection by your staff aren't you assuming responsibility for damage if it occurs? I am hopeful that regulatory oversight on the gas and oil side is as rigorous as it is with the utility companies.
