## I. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On July 22, 2014, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$1,000 for reported over-injection at the Tague #7.
- 2. Staff has reviewed this matter. It appears that there was a discrepancy in Commission records regarding the allowed injection rate at the Tague #7. This discrepancy has been resolved with Operator.
- 3. Based upon the above, Staff recommends that the Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

#### II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the July 22, 2014, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.
