ORDER RESCINDING PENALTY

Upon its own motion, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On July 22, 2014, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$1,000 for reported over-injection at the Tague #7.
2. Staff has reviewed this matter. It appears that there was a discrepancy in Commission records regarding the allowed injection rate at the Tague #7. This discrepancy has been resolved with Operator.
3. Based upon the above, Staff recommends that the Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the July 22, 2014, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


- A. The Penalty Order issued in this docket is rescinded.


