#### LIST OF THRESHOLD LEGAL ISSUES AND PROPOSED INITIAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Anadarko Natural Gas Company ("ANGC"), pursuant to the Prehearing Officer's request during the January 6, 2014 Scheduling Conference, hereby files its List of Threshold Legal Issues and Proposed Initial Procedural Schedule. In order to efficiently proceed in this Docket, ANGC respectfully requests that the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("KCC" or "Commission") issue an Order approving the Initial Procedural Schedule, as set forth below, and the submission of briefs addressing the below List of Threshold Legal Issues.

The parties were unable to reach an agreement on a joint list of issues as suggested by the Prehearing Officer. (*See* attached). As a result, ANGC and the Complainant, SWKI-Stevens Southeast, Inc. and SWKI-Seward West Central, Inc. (collectively, the "NPUs"), will submit separate lists for Commission consideration.

ANGC respectfully requests the Commission order the parties to address all of the legal issues set forth below. Briefs on the threshold issues below will fully address the numerous and complex legal questions to be determined by the Commission in this Docket.

### I. LIST OF THRESHOLD LEGAL ISSUES

**<u>ISSUE 1</u>**: Does the Commission have jurisdiction to determine the merits of the NPUs' Complaints against either or both AESC or ANGC; or must the NPUs' Complaints be dismissed, in whole or in part, due to a lack of KCC jurisdiction?

a. The SWKI-SE Gas Sales Agreement dated July 1, 1998:

(i) On what basis, if any, does the KCC have jurisdiction over AESC?

(ii) On what basis, if any, does the KCC have jurisdiction over the AESC/SWKI-SE Gas Sales Agreement?

(iii) On what basis, if any, does Kansas law provide for a private right of action by SWKI-SE against AESC?

b. The SWKI-SWC Gas Sales Agreement dated June 1, 2002:

(i) On what basis, if any, does the KCC have jurisdiction over ANGC?

(ii) On what basis, if any, does the KCC have jurisdiction over the ANGC/SWKI-SWC Gas Sales Agreement dated July 1, 2002?

(iii) On what basis, if any, does Kansas law provide for a private right of action by SWKI-SWC against ANGC?

c. If the KCC determines that it does have jurisdiction under Kansas law to hear and determine a private right of action with regard to either or both the 1998 SWKI-SE Gas Sales Agreement or the 2002 SWKI-SWC Gas Sales Agreement, is the Commission bound by the terms of the Agreements to order that "[a]ny dispute arising out of or relating to [the] Agreement or the breach, termination, or validity thereof" be finally resolved through binding arbitration in Houston, Texas?

(i) If the KCC is not required to order arbitration of the dispute, may it still do so under Kansas law and the KCC authority to supervise public utilities?

**<u>ISSUE 2</u>**: If the Commission determines that it has jurisdiction to hear one or both of the Complaints filed by the NPUs, according to the terms of the 1998 and 2002 Gas Sales Agreements, may the Commission only consider AESC and ANGC compliance during the most recent two years?

**<u>ISSUE 3</u>**: What is required with regard to each of the Agreements by the Limited Certificate issued to ANGC in Docket No. 00-ANGG-218-COC?

- a. Were the individual NPU gas sales agreements required to be filed with the Commission?
- b. If the individual NPU gas sales agreements were required to be filed with the Commission, and were not, do the NPUs have a private right of action?

**ISSUE 4:** May the Commission order damages or a refund, as claimed by the NPUs?

a. Which party has the burden of proof?

- b. What effect should the full performance of ANGC, AESC, and the NPUs under each gas sales agreement have on the damages requested by the NPUs?
- c. In what manner, if any, do the principles of *quantum meruit* and due process of law apply to the delivery of natural gas pursuant to the 1998 and 2002 Agreements?
- d. If, under Kansas law, the Commission may order a refund, is it required to do so?
- e. Does Kansas law permit the Commission to retroactively modify or amend private contract terms between parties absent a Commission finding that the terms are contrary to the public interest?

#### II. PROPOSED INITIAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The parties discussed an Initial Procedural Schedule during their January 6, 2014 Scheduling Conference. Following those discussions, ANGC submits the following Proposed Initial Procedural Schedule for Commission approval:
