ORDER RESCINDING PENALTY

Upon its own motion, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On August 26, 2014, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$1,000 for unauthorized injection at the Murray #1 SWD.
2. Operator and Staff have discussed this matter. Staff has identified a discrepancy in records regarding the Murray #1 SWD. This discrepancy has been resolved with Operator.
3. Based upon the above, Staff recommends that the Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the August 26, 2014, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


- A. The Penalty Order issued in this docket is rescinded.

B. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as it may deem necessary.


