ORDER APPROVING JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF ENERGY SUPPLY AGREEMENT

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the files and records, and being duly advised, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On August 28, 2018, Kansas Gas and Electric Company, d/b/a Westar Energy, and HollyFrontier El Dorado Refining LLC (together as "Joint Applicants") filed with the Commission a Joint Application requesting approval of an amended Energy Supply Agreement (ESA or Agreement) between Westar and HollyFrontier El Dorado Refining LLC.
- 2. On September 6, 2018, a Suspension Order was filed and the effective date of the above mentioned Joint Application was deferred until April 25, 2019.
- 3. On November 30, 2018, in order to ensure a complete review of the Joint Application and amended ESA, HollyFrontier, Commission Staff, and Westar (together as "Joint Movants") filed a *Joint Motion for Extension of the Energy Supply Agreement* (Joint Motion). The Joint Motion sought extension of the existing ESA because it would expire January 2, 2019, and the Commission may not issue a final order on the Joint Application until April 25, 2019.

4. According to the Joint Motion, Staff has been working to review the Joint

Application and proposed ESA; however, Staff does not expect to have its review completed

prior to January 2, 2019, when the existing ESA will expire.

5. The Joint Movants being in agreement and for good cause shown, the

Commission finds and concludes the Joint Motion should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION CONSIDERED AND CERTIFIED:

A. The terms of the current Energy Supply Agreement shall continue in effect during

the pendency of this docket until the issuance of a final Commission Order.

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by

mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration

of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118b; K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary and proper.
