MOTION FOR DEFAULT ORDER AGAINST NON-APPEARING PROTESTERS

COMES NOW the applicant Robinette Oil Company, LLC by and through undersigned counsel and respectively requests an order finding that protester, Saundra L. Wisdom, failed to attend or participate in the pre-hearing conference and is in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA)¹ and Order Setting Prehearing Conference. In support of its motion, applicant states as follows:

- 1. On June 14, 2019, applicant filed an Application with the Commission seeking a permit to authorize the injection of saltwater into the Zachariah 2-90 and the Zachariah 5-90, both located in the SW/4 of Section 9, Township 9S, Range 20E in Jefferson County, Kansas. Applicant published notice of the Application in The Oskaloosa Independent newspaper on June 6, 2019.
- 2. A letter protesting the Application and request for hearing was filed in the docket by Saundra L. Wisdom. On its own Motion, the Commission designated a Prehearing Officer and scheduled a Prehearing Conference pursuant to K.S.A. 77-516. On July 9, 2019, the Commission filed an Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference in which
