APPLICATION

COMES NOW Berexco LLC ("Operator") in support of its Application in the captioned matter states as follows:

1. Operator is a corporation authorized to do business in the State of Kansas. Operator's address is 2020 N. Bramblewood, Wichita, Kansas 67206.

2. Operator has been issued by the Kansas Corporation Commission Operator's License #34318, which expires on October 30, 2018.

3. Operator is the owner and operator of the McMinimy #4-19 well, API #15-025-21392 which it located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 33 South, Range 21 West, Clark County, Kansas. The subject well is located on an active oil and gas lease comprising the following lands:

McMinimy Lease – All of Section 19, Township 33S, Range 21 West, Clark County, Kansas, containing 640 acres, more or less ("leased premises").

4. Pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-111, Operator obtained temporary abandonment status for the subject well in July, 2007. The subject well has maintained such status from that date to the present date.

5. On October 17, 2017, the Kansas Corporation Commission notified Operator that temporary abandonment status for the subject well would be denied because the subject well had been temporarily abandoned for more than ten (10) years.

6. K.A.R. 82-3-111 imposes a 10-year limitation on the amount of time during which wells may be temporarily abandoned, but an exception to the 10-year limitation may be obtained pursuant to said regulations through an application filed with the Commission pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-100. Operator seeks such an exception.

7. The subject well has demonstrated mechanical integrity, as evidenced by passage of a mechanical integrity test done October 26, 2017, which was witnessed by a member of the Kansas Corporation Commission staff.

8. Operator is holding the subject well for use as a salt water disposal well for its Pfeifer #1 and McMinimy #1-19 wells. The Pfeifer #1 and McMinimy #1-19 wells have potential workovers that could lead to significant water production. Estimated cost to convert McMinimy #4-19 to water disposal is \$50,000. Estimated cost to plug and abandon the subject well is \$20,000

9. Operator has included a plat map showing the locations of all producing, injection, temporarily abandoned, abandoned, and plugged wells located on the same leased premises as the subject well.

10. Based on the foregoing, Operator requests the Commission grant an exception to the 10-year limitation, specifically to allow the subject well to remain eligible for temporary

abandonment status for the three (3) years following the expiration of the 10-year limitation, subject to yearly renewal with the appropriate Conservation Division District, but without further need to re-apply for a new exception each of the three (3) years prayed for in this application to the Commission.

11. Listed in the attached Exhibit "A" are the names and addresses of the following persons:


- A. Each operator of each oil and gas lease covering lands within one-half (1/2) mile radius of the subject well; and
- B. Each person who owns any mineral interest of record in and under any lands located within one-half (1/2) mile radius of the subject well (provided that such mineral interest is not covered by any oil and gas lease).

12. Notice of this application will be published pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-135a. In addition, notice of the hearing to be held in this matter will be provided as prescribed by K.A.R. 82-3-135.

WHEREFORE, Operator prays that this matter be set for hearing, and upon hearing, that the Commission grant Operator's request for an exception to the 10-year limitation during which well may be temporarily abandoned pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-111 so as to allow the subject well to remain temporarily abandoned for three (3) years following the expiration of the 10-year limitation, subject to yearly renewal with the appropriate Conservation Division District, but without further need to re-apply for a new exception each of the three (3) years prayed for in this application.

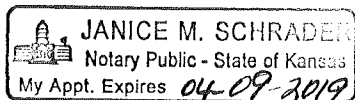



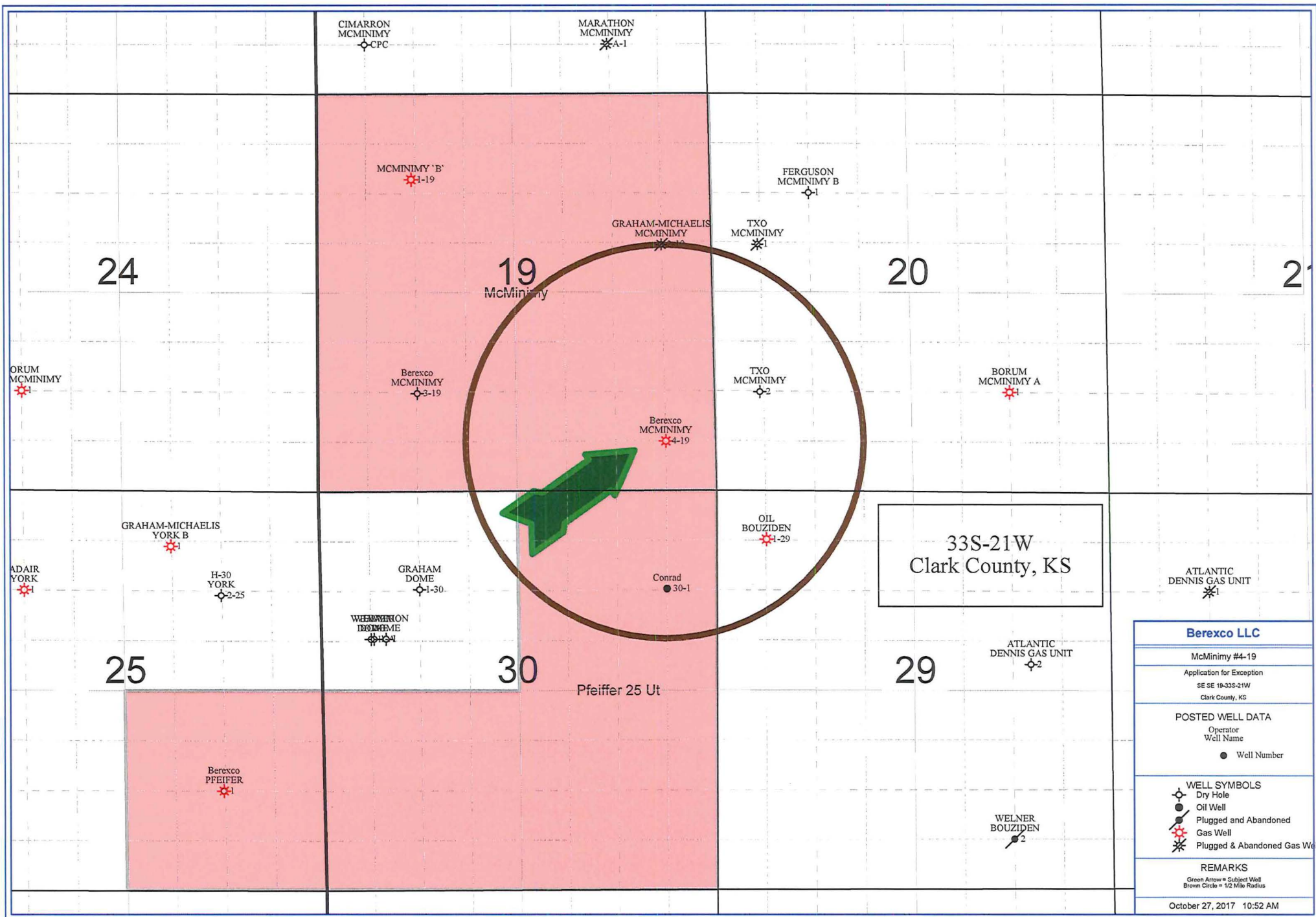
TO: All Oil & Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomever concerned.

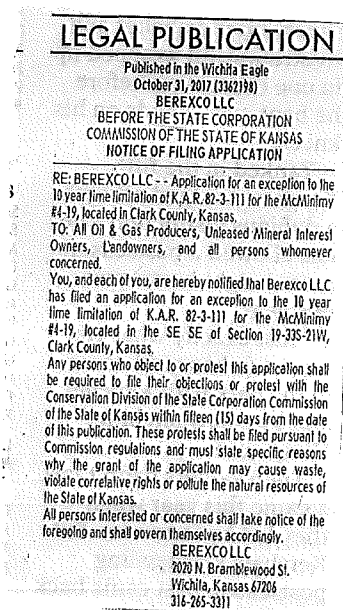
