## APPLICATION OF KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY TO CEASE TRANSACTING THE BUSINESS OF AN ELECTRIC PUBLIC UTILITY IN A PORTION OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY, KANSAS

COMES NOW, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and hereby requests from the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") authorization to cease operating as an electric public utility in a Portion of Section 25, Township 11 South, Range 23 East in Wyandotte County, Kansas. In support of this Application, KCP&L states as follows:

- 1. KCP&L is a vertically integrated electric public utility company under the jurisdiction of the Commission, which is engaged in the production, transmission, delivery and furnishing of power within the meaning of K.S.A. 66-104, in legally designated areas of Kansas. KCP&L holds a certificate of convenience and authority issued by the Commission, authorizing KCP&L to engage in such utility business. KCP&L has previously filed with the Commission certified copies of its Articles of Incorporation under which it was organized and Certificate of Registration as a Foreign Corporation authorized to do business in Kansas, and all amendments thereto and restatements thereof, and the same are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. KCP&L and Westar Energy, Inc. ("Westar") have mutually agreed, subject to approval by the Commission, that as a matter of public convenience and to better serve certain

electric customers, that Westar should serve as the electric public utility in the following described territory:

## WYANDOTTE COUNTY, KANSAS

A tract of land described as the Northwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 25, Township 11 South, Range 23 East in Wyandotte County, as detailed on the map marked Exhibit A and attached hereto.

- 3. The territory described in paragraph 2 above is currently within KCP&L's certificated service territory. Westar currently serves three customers in the territory described in paragraph 2. **Exhibit A** provides an area map of the territory with the areas that KCP&L will transfer to Westar identified.
- 4. Westar will submit a corresponding Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Authority to Transact the Business of an Electric Public Utility for the territory described in paragraph 2.
- 5. This transfer of territory is pursuant to an agreement between KCP&L and Westar which also includes a transfer of territories among Westar and KCP&L in the Spring Hill, Kansas area. The Spring Hill applications will be filed in separate dockets. Due to the location of Westar's and KCP&L's existing facilities in the area, it is in the best interests of the current residents that this service territory be transferred. Westar and KCP&L have agreed that KCP&L will transfer to Westar the territory described in paragraph 2 above.
- 6. A copy of this Application is being served on Cathryn J. Dinges, counsel for Westar, via electronic service. No other person or entity requires notice of this Application.

7. For the foregoing reasons, KCP&L respectfully requests that the Commission authorize KCP&L to cease transacting the business of an electric public utility in the territory described in paragraph 2 of this Application.
