## SUSPENSION ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("Commission") for consideration and decision. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On March 31, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") filed an Application with the Commission for approval of KCP&L's 2010 Energy Efficiency Rider ("EE Rider"), to recover costs incurred January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.

2. On April 5, 2010, the Commission issued an order assessing costs.

3. On April 6, 2010, the Citizen's Utility Ratepayer Board filed a petition to intervene.

4. A full investigation of the Application, which may result in a hearing, is deemed necessary and proper. Commission staff is without sufficient time to fully review, consider and analyze whether the proposed programs are just and reasonable.

5. The Commission finds and concludes that suspension of KCP&L's Application and deferral of its effective date are required to allow sufficient time for full investigation of this matter. The Application should be suspended for a period of 240 days from the date the Application was made, March 31, 2010, until November 26, 2010, pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c).

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c), the Application in the above captioned docket shall be suspended and the effective date deferred until November 26, 2010.

B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this Order is by mail,
from the date of service of this Order in which to request rehearing on any matter decided herein.
K.S.A. 66-118b, K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
