3.10 Restricted Emergency Access Line Service ¹

3.101 <u>General</u>

- A. The Company will provide restricted emergency access line service to business and residential customers where technically feasible and facilities permit.
- B. Conditions applicable to restricted emergency access line service are:
 - 1. No outgoing local calls.
 - 2. No outgoing long distance calls.
 - 3. Outgoing E911 calls allowed.
 - 4. Outgoing 711 abbreviated dialing calls allowed.
 - 5. Unlimited incoming calls.
 - 6. No directory listing is provided.
 - 7. Regular service connection charges apply upon installation.
- C. Customers ordering restricted emergency access line service will be cautioned about its' limitations. Customers will be required to execute an agreement which holds the Company harmless from any damages which may arise and which absolves the Company from any responsibility for the failure of the customer to place calls because of the restricted service.

(N) 3.11 Virtual Phone Number Service

A. General

- 1. Virtual phone number service (VPNS) allows a customer to establish a telephone number that forwards calls to a customer designated group of telephone instruments.
- 2. For calls forwarded to non-local telephone instruments, call forwarding and applicable long distance charges will apply.

B. Rates and Charges

- 1. The charges for VPNS are in addition to other rates specified in this tariff and service connection charges, when applicable.
- 2. VPNS monthly rate, per assigned telephone instrument \$2.00
