PREHEARING OFFICER ORDER CONTINUING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Prehearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. September 15, 2017, Veem Jade Oil & Gas LLC (Operator) filed an Application for Exception from the K.A.R. 82-3-111(b) 10-Year Limit regarding the Operator's Smith A #1 and Smith B #8 wells located in Township 29 South, Range 9 East, Elk County, Kansas.¹
2. On July 17, 2018, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*, scheduling a Prehearing Conference for August 9, 2018.²
3. On August 9, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was held, wherein the parties agreed to a continuance of the Prehearing Conference.
4. Based on the above, the Prehearing Officer finds the Prehearing Conference shall be continued until October 11, 2018, at 9:00 a.m.
