TO: All Oil and Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whosever concerned, You, and each one of you, are hereby notified that F.G. Holl Company, L.L.C. has filed an application with Kansas Corporation Commission for an exception to the Pit Closure time limitation regulation for its ILS Land "A" #1-1 well located in the NE/4 of Section 1-Township 19 South and Range 14 West, Barton County, Kansas.

Any persons who object or protest against this application shall be required to file their concerns with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within 30 days from the date of the publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specific reasons why the grant of the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the state of Kansas. If no protests are received, this application may be granted through a summary proceeding. If valid protests are received, this matter will be set for hearing.

All persons interested or concerned shall take notice of the foregoing and shall govern themselves accordingly.
