**ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. On January 9, 2018, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*.
2. On March 9, 2018, a Prehearing Conference was held where Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) and Smith Oil Operations (Smith Oil) agreed to the following procedural schedule:

Staff's Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due: May 7, 2018
Smith Oil's Pre-filed Direct Testimony	Due: May 29, 2018
Rebuttal Testimony	Due: June 4, 2018
Evidentiary Hearing before the Commission 266 N. Main, Suite 220, Wichita, Kansas 67202	June 14, 2018, 10:00 a.m.

3. Failure to submit pre-filed testimony may result in the Commission restricting the right to testify and present evidence at the evidentiary hearing. At the hearing, the Commission may limit direct and rebuttal testimony to the pre-filed testimony.

4. Any settlement agreement the parties wish to present for Commission consideration shall be due by June 4, 2018.

5. Any person requiring special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act should notify the Commission at least 10 days before the scheduled hearing date.

6. Any party who fails to attend or participate in the evidentiary hearing or in any other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.<sup>1</sup>

**THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

A. The procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 2 is adopted.

B. The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if mailed service, in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration.<sup>2</sup>

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
