Dear Mr. Palmateer:

The facts set forth in your "Motion to Set Application for Hearing" are correct, including the description of the well testing schedule that I had proposed for the remaining wells. When I wrote my letter dated July 31, 2014 proposing August - September test dates for two of the three remaining wells, I did not realize that our pulling unit and our packer and workstring still were rigged up and in the Oscar West 406. And that well is surrounded by crops.


As soon as the crops are harvested, we will pull our tubing and packer out of the 406 and then will test the 403, followed immediately by the 204 and 407.

I understand your frustration and can accelerate our schedule if necessary. On the other hand, if we can wait just a few more weeks for harvest, then we will be able to accomplish the necessary work without destroying a chunk of the farmer's crop.
