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APPLICATION

Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. ("Magellan"), pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,215, *et seq.*, and other applicable statutes, makes this Application to the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("KCC" or "Commission") for an order approving Magellan's Pipeline Capacity Lease Agreement dated September 5, 2025 with ONEOK North System, L.L.C. ("ONS") ("ONS Agreement") that is attached to this Application as **Exhibit A** and amending Magellan's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to transact the business of a liquids pipeline contract carrier relating to its 8-inch pipeline that runs between Wichita, Kansas, and El Dorado, Kansas, as shown on the map that is attached to this Application as **Exhibit B**.

In support thereof, Magellan states as follows:

1. Magellan is a Delaware limited partnership with its principal offices and place of business located at 100 West Fifth Street, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74103. Magellan is a liquids pipeline common carrier that is engaged in the transportation of liquid hydrocarbons in accordance with K.S.A. 66-105, and K.S.A. 66-1,215, *et al.* Magellan operates an intrastate liquids pipeline system in the State of Kansas transporting petroleum products between various points through the state. Magellan has certificates for authority to do business in the State of Kansas issued by the Kansas Corporation Commission ("Commission"). Magellan is the owner and operator of a new eight-inch liquids

pipeline located between Wichita, Kansas and El Dorado, Kansas. ("Wichita/ElDorado Pipeline").

3. Magellan is seeking an order from the Commission approving the ONS Agreement and allowing Magellan to fulfill its contractual obligations under the ONS Agreement and is requesting a limited contract carrier certificate or permit from the Commission. A copy of the ONS Agreement is attached to this Application as **Exhibit A** and is incorporated herein by reference. Because public release of the ONS Agreement could give Magellan's competitors in the liquids pipeline industry a competitive advantage, the ONS Agreement has been designated as *confidential* pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1220a, in that the ONS Agreement has not been disclosed to the public and the parties to the ONS Agreement have contractually agreed to keep such non-public information confidential because of the competitive nature of the liquids pipeline business.

4. The capacity in Magellan's new Wichita/El Dorado Pipeline is being leased to ONS. Magellan will continue to own and operate the Wichita/El Dorado Pipeline. ONS intends to use the leased capacity to provide services under its K.C.C. No. 4.19 Tariff. *See*, Application filed August 28, 2025 in Docket No. 26-ONSP-084-TAR.

5. The request by Magellan in this case is limited specifically to allowing Magellan authority to fulfill its contractual obligations under the ONS Agreement. Magellan is not requesting any authority beyond its limited request; is specifically not requesting any common carrier authority under this Application; and specifically has not held, and is not holding itself or the pipeline

referenced herein that it owns and operates, out for use by the public. Magellan will make a notice filing with the Commission in this docket with respect to any subsequent changes to the terms and conditions of the ONS Agreement. Magellan requests that its limited contract carrier certificate or permit granted by the Commission in this docket expire or terminate immediately upon termination of the ONS Agreement.¹

6. Magellan states that the approval of the ONS Agreement will promote the public interest in that Magellan is qualified by its experience and financial strength to meet all of the demands associated with fulfilling its contractual obligations under the ONS Agreement and that ONS requires the use of the capacity in the Wichita/El Dorado Pipeline in conjunction with its liquids pipeline operations.

WHEREFORE, Magellan respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order approving the ONS Agreement, granting Magellan a limited contract carrier certificate or permit to own and operate the Wichita/El Dorado Pipeline in order to fulfill its obligations under the ONS Agreement and any further relief and authority as found by the Commission to be just and reasonable.

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


