PRESIDING OFFICER ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the Presiding Officer for consideration and decision. The Presiding Officer finds the following:

1. On December 21, 2021, the Commission issued a penalty to Mast Trucking totaling \$6,500 in civil fines comprised of four alleged violations.¹ The four alleged violations included a \$5,000 enhanced fine for allowing or permitting drivers to falsify records of duty status. Mast Trucking previously received a penalty for the same violation by Penalty Order dated March 10, 2020.²
2. On August 11, 2022, the Presiding Officer issued an Order Setting Procedural Schedule which included the following deadlines.

3. On September 20, 2022, Commission Staff file an Unopposed Motion to Extend Time, requesting all deadlines in the procedural schedule in this docket be extended for thirty days.³

4. Under K.A.R. 82-1-217(b), a deadline may be extended for good cause shown. The Presiding Officer finds Staff's motion demonstrates good cause. The Procedural Schedule shall be amended as follows:

5. The Evidentiary Hearing, scheduled for November 3, 2022, is cancelled and will be rescheduled if necessary in a subsequent Order.

A. The Procedural Schedule issued August 11, 2022, is amended as found in paragraphs 4 and 5 of this Order.
