## PRESIDING OFFICER ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter comes before the Presiding Officer for consideration and decision. The Presiding Officer finds the following:

1. On December 21, 2021, the Commission issued a penalty to Mast Trucking totaling

\$6,500 in civil fines comprised of four alleged violations.<sup>1</sup> The four alleged violations included a \$5,000 enhanced fine for allowing or permitting drivers to falsify records of duty status. Mast Trucking previously received a penalty for the same violation by Penalty Order dated March 10, 2020.<sup>2</sup>

2. On August 11, 2022, the Presiding Officer issued an Order Setting Procedural
