ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having examined the files, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On January 28, 2014, Mid-Kansas Electric Company, LLC (Mid-Kansas) furnished to the Commission, for informational purposes, its contract between Mid-Kansas and Abengoa Bioenergy Biomass of Kansas, LLC, (Abengoa) for the purchase of wholesale energy from Abengoa.

2. Mid-Kansas is a cooperative exempt from the Commission's jurisdiction, with limited exception, pursuant to K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-104d. On November 22, 2013, Mid-Kansas filed its Notice of Election to Deregulate in Docket No. 14-MKEE-253-DRC, and on January 7, 2014, the Commission acknowledged and affirmed Mid-Kansas' election.¹

3. Staff reviewed Mid-Kansas' informational filing to ensure the subject contract did not fall within the Commission's retained jurisdiction over deregulated cooperatives pursuant to K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-104d(f). Staff determined the contract was not subject to Commission

approval, and submitted its findings in a Report and Recommendation, dated August 26, 2014. Staff's Report and Recommendation is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

4. In its Report and Recommendation, Staff finds no Commission action is necessary and recommends this docket be closed.

5. Upon review of Staff's Report and Recommendation, the Commission adopts Staff's Report and Recommendation, and finds that no Commission action is necessary and this docket should be closed.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

(A) Mid-Kansas' informational filing is acknowledged and this docket is closed.

(B) The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein.²

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Mid-Kansas Electric Company, LLC submitted an information filing to provide notification of confidential contracts entered into by Mid-Kansas for the purchase of wholesale energy from Abengoa Bioenergy Biomass of Kansas, LLC. However, Mid-Kansas is exempt from Commission jurisdiction, regulation, supervision, and control as provided in K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-104d(b), except to the extent of jurisdiction and authority retained pursuant to K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 66-104d(f). The contracts submitted in this docket do not fall under this exception. Therefore, no Commission action is necessary and Staff recommends Docket No. 14-MKEE-354-CON be closed.

BACKGROUND:

Mid-Kansas Electric Company, LLC (Mid-Kansas) submitted an informational filing on January 28, 2014, with the Kansas Corporation Commission (Commission) to provide notification of confidential contracts entered into by Mid-Kansas for purchase of wholesale energy from Abengoa Bioenergy Biomass of Kansas, LLC (ABBK). In Docket No. 14-MKEE-253-DRC, Mid-Kansas filed its Deregulation Notice with the Commission. The Commission affirmed Mid-Kansas' Deregulation Notice in that Docket, making them exempt from the jurisdiction,



regulation, supervision, and control of the Commission effective January 07, 2014, subject to the Commission's continuing jurisdiction under K.S.A. 66-104d(f) and any Commission jurisdiction which may arise under K.S.A. 66-104d(g) and (j).

ANALYSIS:

Because Mid-Kansas has obtained a majority vote to opt out of Commission regulation pursuant to K.S.A. 66-104d(c)(4), Mid-Kansas is exempt from Commission jurisdiction, regulation, supervision, and control as provided in K.S.A. 66-104d(b), except to the extent of jurisdiction and authority retained pursuant to K.S.A. 66-104d(f). Docket No. 14-MKEE-354-CON does not fall within the exceptions provided in K.S.A. 66-104d(f). Since Mid-Kansas is exempt from Commission jurisdiction, regulation, supervision, and control, Staff recommends closing Docket No. 14-MKEE-354-CON.

RECOMMENDATION:

Mid-Kansas is exempt from Commission jurisdiction, regulation, supervision, and control as provided in K.S.A. 66-104d(b), except to the extent of jurisdiction and authority retained pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 66-104d(f). Docket No. 14-MKEE-354-CON does not fall within the exceptions provided, therefore no Commission action is necessary and Staff recommends this docket be closed.
