ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Now, the above-captioned matter comes on before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas ("KCC" or "Commission") on its own motion. The Commission, being duly advised in the premises and after giving due consideration to the Statutes of Kansas, the regulations of the Commission, and its records and files, makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. By Order dated February 24, 1993, the Commission established the Terry Marmaton Oil Pool to govern well spacing and/or proration, and production of oil from the Marmaton formation located in the following acreage:

Section 34, Township 22 South, Range 34 West, Finney County.

2. By Order dated February 24, 1993, the Commission established the Terry Mississippian St. Louis Oil Pool to govern well spacing and/or proration, and production of oil from the Mississippian St. Louis formation located in the following acreage:

Section 34, Township 22 South, Range 34 West, Finney County.

3. By Order dated February 24, 1993, the Commission established the Terry Lansing-Kansas City Oil Pool to govern well spacing and/or proration, and production of oil from the Lansing-Kansas City formation located in the following acreage:

Section 34, Township 22 South, Range 34 West, Finney County.

4. The above-referenced fields have been identified by Commission staff as candidates to have the Basic Proration Orders covering the fields dissolved due to the depletion of the subject reservoirs and the lack of production from the wells in the fields.

5. The Commission is charged with the jurisdiction and authority to regulate oil and gas activities pursuant to K.S.A. 74-623 and to prevent waste pursuant to K.S.A. 55-601 and K.S.A. 55-701. The Commission has the jurisdiction to institute proceedings for the purpose of fulfilling said responsibility and to enforce the laws of the State of Kansas.

6. In view of the foregoing, the Commission finds that all parties in interest shall be directed to appear and show cause as to why the above-referenced Basic Proration Orders should not be dissolved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED: That all parties in interest be, and the same are, hereby directed to appear before this Commission at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, on April 19, 2012, in the Hearing Room of the Conservation

Division, 130 South Market, Room 2078, Wichita, Kansas, 67202-3802, to show cause why said Basic Proration Orders should not be dissolved.

The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further order or orders as from time to time it may deem proper.
