This letter acknowledges receipt of your letter of protest to the referenced application. For your protest to comply with K.A.R. 82-3-135b(a) you need to mail a copy of the protest letter to the applicant and provide us with a certificate of service.

Once we have received the certificate of service we will docket your protest and start the process of setting the application for an evidentiary hearing before the Commission.

A Prehearing Officer will be appointed and a Prehearing Conference will be scheduled. Most Prehearing Conferences are held via telephone and you will be advised of the date and time, and call in information. The Prehearing Conference is mostly for setting a hearing date and establishing the procedural schedule.

The Commission hearings are held at the Commission's office in Wichita and open to the public; however, only parties to the proceedings are allowed to present evidence and participate.
