MOTION TO CANCEL PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND CLOSE DOCKET

On October 18, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting that an order to show cause be issued against Operator, based upon Commission records indicating that an unplugged well remained on Operator's expired license. On January 12, 2017, the Commission issued an Order to Show Cause, setting a February 9, 2017, prehearing conference. The prehearing conference was subsequently continued to May 4, 2017.

Based upon conversations with Operator and other individuals, and a full review of Commission files, Staff currently believes it is more likely than not that Operator is not responsible for the well in question. Staff has removed the well from Operator's expired license and will determine whether there is a viable, different responsible party against which to initiate proceedings. Accordingly, Staff asks that the prehearing conference be cancelled and that this docket be closed.
