## ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER; ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION TO THE CITIZENS' UTILITY RATEPAYER BOARD

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This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On September 15, 2014, Westar Energy, Inc. and Kansas Gas and Electric Company (collectively Westar) filed a Petition Initiating Docket to make certain changes in their charges for electric service.

2. Westar also requested the Commission issue a Discovery Order and Protective Order so that the advance audit process can commence. Westar requested the Discovery and Protective Order be limited to matters related to the audit of the La Cygne Environmental Project only until such time as Westar files its application in this docket, at which point full discovery would be permitted.

3. On September 23, 2014, the Commission granted Westar's request to initiate the docket and issued a limited Discovery and Protective Order. As Westar requested, the Discovery and Protective orders were limited to matters related to the audit of the La Cygne Environmental Project.

#### I. Order Designating Prehearing Officer

4. Although the Commission will conduct the evidentiary hearing, the Commission designates a prehearing officer to conduct any prehearing conferences that may be necessary, to address any matters appropriately considered in a prehearing conference, including all items listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b) of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). The Commission designates Jay Van Blaricum, Assistant General Counsel, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, KS 66604-4027, telephone number (785) 271-3186, j.vanblaricum@kcc.ks.gov to serve as Prehearing Officer in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> The Commission may designate other staff members to serve in this capacity.

## **II.** Order Granting Intervention to the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board (CURB)

5. On September 22, 2014, CURB filed a Petition to Intervene.<sup>2</sup> In its Petition, CURB stated that it is composed of five volunteer consumer advocate members statutorily authorized to represent the interests of Kansas residential and small commercial ratepayers in any utility proceeding before the Commission under K.S.A. 66-1223, *et seq.*<sup>3</sup> CURB requests permission to intervene as the rates paid by those customers will or may be affected by any Commission order or activity in this proceeding.<sup>4</sup>

6. The Commission has broad discretion to grant a petition for intervention if it is in the interest of justice, if the intervention will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings, and if the party has stated facts demonstrating its legal rights, duties and privileges, immunities or other legal interests may be substantially affected by the proceeding.<sup>5</sup>

Furthermore, at any time during a proceeding, the Commission may impose limitations on an intervenor's participation.<sup>6</sup>

7. The Commission finds and concludes that CURB has met the requirements of K.A.R. 82-1-225 and K.S.A. 77-521 and should be granted intervention in this Docket. CURB will be added to the mailing list, service of pleadings, communications, and correspondence should be delivered to counsel of record, as follows:

(B) The Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board is granted intervention in the abovecaptioned proceeding. Counsel of record for the petitioner, and its other designees, shall receive service of all pleadings in this matter, as set forth above.
