ORDER GRANTING WAIVER OF DEADLINE

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On December 5, 2014, Westar Energy, Inc. ("Westar") filed an Application requesting Commission approval to transact business as an electric public utility in portions of Leavenworth County, Kansas.
2. Likewise, on December 16, 2014, in Docket Number 15-LVJE-256-CCS, Leavenworth Jefferson Electric Cooperative ("Leavenworth Jefferson") filed an Application requesting Commission approval to cease the transaction of business as an electric public utility in portions of Leavenworth County, Kansas.
3. On May 20, 2015, Staff filed its motion seeking a waiver of the 180-day deadline pursuant to K.S.A. 66-131, noting both Westar and Leavenworth Jefferson were unopposed to the waiver and extension. Staff requested a new deadline of July 23, 2015 relevant to Westar's Application.

4. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 66-131(b) requires the Commission issue an order on an application for certificate of public convenience and necessity within 180 days; however nothing in that section precludes the parties and Commission from agreeing to a waiver of the 180-day period.

5. The Commission finds Staff's request, unopposed by Westar and Leavenworth Jefferson, to be reasonable and therefore should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

(A) Staff's Motion for Waiver is granted and the new deadline for decision on Westar's Application in this docket shall be July 23, 2015.


(B) The parties have fifteen (15) days, plus three (3) days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was served in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein.¹

(C) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary and proper.
