ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

1. On September 15, 2017, Veem Jade Oil & Gas LLC (Operator) filed an Application for an exception from the K.A.R. 82-3-111(b) 10-Year Limit regarding the Operator's Smith A #1 and Smith B #8 wells located in Township 29 South, Range 9 East, Elk County, Kansas.¹
2. On June 21, 2018, Commission Conservation Staff (Staff) filed a Motion for the Designation of a Prehearing Officer and the Scheduling of a Prehearing Conference (Staff's Motion).
3. On July 17, 2018, the Commission issued its *Order Designating Prehearing Officer and Setting Prehearing Conference*.
4. On October 18, 2018, the Commission issued an *Order Setting Procedural Schedule*, scheduling an evidentiary hearing for January 24, 2019.²
5. On December 17, 2018, the Operator filed a Withdrawal and Motion to Dismiss Application, wherein the Operator stated "that it has completed testing and evaluation of the subject

wells, and has determined that the wells should be plugged.”³ The Operator further stated that “[t]he wells were plugged on December 14, 2018. The CP4 forms for the wells have been filed with the Commission”⁴ and “Staff counsel does not object to dismissal of the Application.”⁵

6. Based on the Operator’s withdrawal of its Application and Motion to Dismiss, the Commission finds the Operator’s Application should be dismissed and the docket closed.

THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

A. The Operator’s Withdrawal and Motion to Dismiss Application is granted, and the docket is closed.


B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).⁶
