ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER AND SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

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This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the pleadings and record, the Commission makes the following findings:

1. On May 2, 2016, Western Cooperative Electric Association, Inc. (Western) filed

its Application seeking Commission approval to update its Local Access Delivery Service (LADS) tariff. The Application was filed pursuant to Western's 34.5kV Formula-Based Rate

Plan (34.5kV FBR Plan), approved in Docket No. 16-MKEE-023-TAR.¹

2. On May 4, 2016, an Order Assessing Costs was filed in the docket.

3. On May 9, 2016, William G. Riggins entered his appearance on behalf of Kansas

Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (KEPCo) in the above-captioned matter.

4. On May 16, 2016, Curtis M. Irby entered his appearance on behalf of Linde, Inc.

5. A Suspension Order, Discovery Order, and Protective Order was filed on May 19, 2016, suspending the Application for a period of 240 days pursuant to K.S.A. 66-117(c) from the date it was filed on May 2, 2016 until December 28, 2016.

6. An Entry of Appearance was filed by Mark D. Calcara and Taylor P. Calcara on behalf of Western Cooperative Electric Association, Inc. on May 26, 2016.

7. A Joint Motion for Procedural Order was filed by Western, Staff of the State Corporation Commission (Staff), KEPCo, and Linde, Inc. (collectively referred to as Joint Movants) on June 10, 2016, recommending an agreed schedule to the Commission for its review and approval.

8. The Commission designates Samuel Feather, Deputy General Counsel, 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, KS 66604-4027, telephone number (785) 271-3240, <u>s.feather@kcc.ks.gov</u>, to serve as Prehearing Officer in this proceeding.² The prehearing officer may conduct any prehearing conferences necessary to address any matters appropriately considered in a prehearing conference, including all items listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b) of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). The Commission may designate other staff members to serve in this capacity.
