ORDER APPROVING NAME CHANGE

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. On March 4, 2021, One Point Technologies, Inc. (One Point) filed an Application requesting that its name on all Commission records be changed to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc.
2. The Commission derives its authority to supervise telecommunications public utilities from K.S.A. 66-1,188.
3. On March 30, 2021, the Commission Staff (Staff) submitted its Report and Recommendation, attached hereto and made a part hereof, recommending the Commission grant One Point Technologies, Inc.'s Application and approve the request to change the name on its Certificate to provide Local Exchange and Exchange Access Services within the state of Kansas to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc.
4. The Commission adopts Staffs analysis and recommendation of March 30, 2021, as stated in its Report and Recommendation, and finds that the Application filed in this matter by One Point Technologies, Inc. should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

A. One Point Technologies, Inc.'s Application filed in this matter requesting a name change from One Point Technologies, Inc. to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. on its Certificate to provide Local Exchange Access Services within the State of Kansas is hereby approved.

B. Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. is reminded to notify the Commission immediately of any change in address or contact telephone numbers, file timely annual reports, maintain current registration with the Kansas Secretary of State's office, and pay all KUSF and Commission assessments in a timely manner.

C. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On March 4, 2021, One Point Technologies, Inc. (One Point) filed an Application requesting the Commission change its name in all Commission records to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. Staff recommends approval of this Application.

BACKGROUND:

The Commission derives its authority to supervise telecommunications public utilities from K.S.A. 66-1,188.

ANALYSIS:

One Point requests that the name on its Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide Local and Exchange Access Services within the state of Kansas be changed to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. The Company states no customer will experience any interruption, delay, or change as a result of this change.

One Point was issued a Certificate of Convenience and Authority to provide Switched Local Exchange Access Services on February 6, 2007, in Docket No. 11-OPPT-594-COC.

Blue Valley Technologies, Inc. is properly registered with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office and authorized to engage in business in Kansas. It is currently "active and in good standing" with the Secretary's Office. One Point is current with regard to payments to the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) and payment of Commission assessments. The Company has a current Annual Interrogatory on file.

Replacement Access tariffs with the new name must be filed in this Docket.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of One Point' Application to change the name on its Certificate to provide Local Exchange and Exchange Access Services within the state of Kansas to Blue Valley Technologies, Inc.. The Company is reminded to notify the Commission immediately of any change in address or contact telephone numbers, file timely annual reports, maintain current registration with the Kansas Secretary of State's Office, and pay all Commission and KUSF assessments in a timely manner.
