**ORDER GRANTING RECONSIDERATION: AMENDING VSA TO REMOVE  
BALDWIN CITY**

NOW, the above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed its files and records and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission makes the following findings:

**Background**

1. On May 5, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Granting VSA Termination* (Order) granting an Application to Terminate filed by Valu-Net, LLC (Valu-Net) on March 18, 2020.

2. On May 8, 2020, Valu-Net filed a *Petition for Reconsideration* (PFR) explaining that it had incorrectly populated the application document as a “termination.” Valu-Net had intended only to cease providing service in Baldwin City, Kansas. Therefore, it should have filed an Application to Amend its VSA in this matter. Valu-Net asked the Commission to reconsider its May 5, 2020, Order to amend its VSA to remove Baldwin City from its service area rather than terminate its VSA entirely. Valu-Net noted that it coordinated with Staff in an effort to correct this matter.

3. Attached to its PFR, Valu-Net submitted a correctly populated amended application, indicating a request for termination of Valu-Net’s VSA for Baldwin City, KS only

(Community Unit Identification (“CUID”) information: The City of Baldwin City, KS, CUID# KS0833) (the “Revised Application,” attached as Attachment A).

### **Jurisdiction and Standard of Review**

4. VSA amendments are authorized under K.S.A. 66-2023.
5. K.A.R. 82-15-1(b)(2) provides:  
  
(2) Each entity that holds a video service authorization certificate and wants to revise its original application shall file an amended application, except as provided in subsection (e).

### **Findings and Conclusions**

6. The Commission finds that Valu-Net has provided an adequate basis to grant the requested PFR. The Commission finds that Valu-Net has submitted a Revised Application conforming to the requirements of K.S.A. 66-2023 and K.A.R. 82-15-1(b)(2) which should be granted.

7. Therefore, the Commission finds it appropriate to grant Valu-Net’s PFR in this matter.

### **IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

- A. Valu-Net’s PFR is granted.
- B. Valu-Net’s VSA is hereby amended to remove Baldwin City from its service territory. Valu-Net remains authorized to provide video service in all other previously authorized areas.
- C. Staff is directed to update its VSA records to reflect the same.
- D. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).
- E. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of issuing such further order, or orders, as it may deem necessary.
