**ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and decision. Having reviewed the files and records, and being duly advised, the Commission finds:

1. On May 1, 2017, Victory Electric Cooperative Association, Inc. (Victory), filed its Application seeking approval to make changes to its Local Access Delivery Service (LADS) charge assessed to wholesale users of Victory's 34.5kV system. The filing was made in accordance with the 34.5kV Formula Based Rate (34.5kV FBR) plan established and approved by the Commission in Docket No. 16-MKEE-023-TAR.<sup>1</sup>

2. On May 11, 2017, the Commission filed a Suspension Order, Protective Order and Discovery Order.<sup>2</sup>

3. On May 25, 2017, Victory, Staff and Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (KEPCo) filed a Joint Motion for Procedural Order, requesting Commission approval of a proposed procedural schedule as set forth in the 34.5kV FBR plan Protocols. The Commission adopts the following procedural schedule:


**THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**
