This is a notice of a penalty assessment against Tanner Moore d/b/a Moore's Bobcat Service Hauling and Excavating (Moore's Bobcat Service) for violation(s) of Kansas Motor Carrier Safety Statutes, Rules, and Regulations discovered during a compliance review conducted on September 21, 2023, by Kansas Corporation Commission Special Investigator Matt Adams. Penalties are assessed in accordance with the FY 2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix, approved by the Commission on June 29, 2023. For a full description of the penalty(s) and terms and obligations please refer to the Order attached to this notice.

IF YOU ACCEPT THE PENALTY: Moore's Bobcat Service has been assessed a \$1,250 penalty. You have thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order to pay the penalty. Please remit payment of \$1,250, through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory Assistance Network (KTRAN) systemlocated at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. If you have not received a letter from the Transportation Division assigning you a PIN, please contact that Division at 785-271-3145. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty owed.

The attached Order requires a representative of Moore's Bobcat Service to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order and to provide the undersigned Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule of dates and locations for safety seminars can be found at the Commission's website http://www.kcc.state.ks.us/trans/safety_meetings.htm.

IF YOU CONTEST THE PENALTY ORDER: You have the right to request a hearing. A request for a hearing must be made in writing, setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. Moore's Bobcat Service must file, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, the request for hearing with the Commission's electronic filing system found at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, and mail a copy of the request for hearing to the undersigned at the above address. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy to the undersigned Litigation Counsel.1

IF YOU FAIL TO ACT: Failure to pay the penalty of \$1,250 within thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Penalty Order or failure to comply with the terms of the Order, or in the alternative, failure to provide a timely written request for a hearing, will result in the Order becoming final and may result in additional sanctions of suspension and/or revocation of your motor carrier operating authority.

PENALTY ORDER

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On September 21, 2023, Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) Matt Adams, completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Tanner Moore d/b/a Moore's Bobcat Service Hauling and Excavating (Moore's Bobcat Service or Carrier). Moore's Bobcat Service is a motor carrier as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5, and operates under USDOT number 3077576.
- 2. On October 17, 2023, Staff submitted its Report and Recommendation (R&R), attached hereto as Attachment "A" and is hereby incorporated by reference, recommending a penalty of \$1,250 to be issued to Moore's Bobcat Service based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered. Staff's R&R indicates that as a result of the safety compliance investigations, SI Matt Adams identified three (3) violation(s), accounting for two (2) count(s), of

the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carry a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.²

- 3. Additionally, Staff recommends that Moore's Bobcat Service be required to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.³ A schedule of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety_meetings.htm.
- 4. Staff further recommends Moore's Bobcat Service submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.⁴
- 5. Finally, Staff recommends that Moore's Bobcat Service submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. ⁵ Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for this review.
- 6. Pursuant to K.S.A 66-1,108b, 66-1,111, 66-1,112, 66-1,114b, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5 as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority and jurisdiction.

- 7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130 and 66-1,142b, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision or regulation of the Commission.
- 8. The Commission has the authority, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-1-237, to investigate an entity under the Commission's jurisdiction and issue an order on the Commission's own motion when the Commission believes the entity is in violation of the law or any order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. Tanner Moore d/b/a Moore's Bobcat Service Hauling and Excavating, of Auburn, KS is hereby assessed a \$1,250 civil penalty for three (3) violation(s), accounting for two (2) count(s), of Kansas law governing the regulation of motor carriers, the Kansas Administrative Regulations and provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations.
- B. Moore's Bobcat Service is hereby ordered to have a representative responsible for the Carrier's safety compliance attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, and is to provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance.
- C. Carrier is hereby ordered to submit a written, comprehensive corrective action plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in this Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining Carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

- D. Moore's Bobcat Service is ordered to submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of this Order. Transportation Staff will contact the Carrier to set up the appointment.
- E. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537 and K.S.A. 77-542, any party may request a hearing on the above issue(s) by submitting a written request setting forth the specific grounds upon which relief is sought. The request may be electronically filed with the Commission's electronic filing system at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/e-filing/e-express/, within fifteen (15) days from the date of service of this Order, and a copy of the request mailed to the Litigation Division. If you do not have access to the internet, you can mail an original and seven copies of the request to the Executive Director at 1500 S.W. Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas 66604, and mail a copy of the request to Litigation Counsel. A hearing will be scheduled only upon written request. Failure to timely request a hearing will result in a waiver of Moore's Bobcat Service's right to a hearing, and this Penalty Order will become a Final Order.
- F. If a request for hearing is filed, attorneys for all parties shall enter their appearances in Commission proceedings by giving their names and addresses for the record. For civil penalties exceeding \$500, a corporation shall appear before the Commission by its attorney, unless waived by the Commission for good cause shown and a determination that such waiver is in the public interest.⁶ For civil penalties less than \$500, a corporation may appear by a duly authorized representative of the corporation.⁷
- G. If you do not request a hearing, the payment of the civil penalty of \$1,250 is due in thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Order. Payment of \$1,250 must be made through your personal account with the Kansas Corporation Commission's Kansas Trucking Regulatory

Assistance Network (KTRAN) system located at https://puc.kcc.ks.gov/ktran/. You must have an account through KTRAN to pay the penalty.

H. Failure to pay the \$1,250 civil penalty within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this Penalty Order and/or failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in suspension of Moore's Bobcat Service's motor carrier operating authority without further notice. Additionally, the Commission may impose further sanctions to include, but not limited to, the issuance and enforcement of revocation of authority and/or cease and desist orders, and any other remedies available to the Commission by law, without further notice.

Penalties, Sanctions and/or the Revocation of Motor Carrier Authority

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Tanner Moore d/b/a Moore's Bobcat Service (Tanner Moore) is a motor carrier (MC) operating public for-hire, primarily hauling construction, rock and other aggregates. Tanner Moore operates under USDOT 3077576. On September 21, 2023, Commission Staff Special Investigator (SI) Matt Adams completed a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Tanner Moore. A copy of the safety compliance report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and is hereby incorporated by reference. As a result of this investigation, the SI identified three (3) violations accounting for two (2) specific counts of the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (MCSRs), which carry a penalty according to the FY2024 Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix approved by the Commission. Based on the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations discovered by the SI, staff recommends penalty of \$1,250 be issued to the MC.

DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS:

On September 21, 2023, Commission Staff SI Matt Adams conducted a safety compliance investigation of the operations of Tanner Moore. The investigation covers a 365 day period. Each specific count is detailed below.

Count 1 (1 of 2)

<u>Jurisdiction:</u> 49 C.F.R. 382.711, adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3c, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129. <u>Intent of Law:</u> The MC must be enrolled in the FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse (DACH).

<u>Supporting documents</u>: On June 16, 2023, Tanner Moore allowed or permitted its driver, Bruce Moore, to operate a commercial driver's license (CDL) required commercial motor vehicle (CMV), a 2005 International dump truck, VIN ending in 0843, GVWR 62,000 pounds, in intrastate commerce from Auburn, Kansas to Topeka, Kansas. This transport is evidenced by a driver's time sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and an invoice, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**. Additionally, a copy of the MC's DACH search is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**.

<u>Violation:</u> The MC failed to register in the DACH (**Exhibit 1**, **Page 3**). One (1) violation was discovered.

Recommendation: Staff recommends a violation of \$750.

Count Two (2 of 2)

Jurisdiction: 49 C.F.R. 391.51(b)(2) and (4), adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3g, and authorized by K.S.A. 66-1,129.

<u>Intent of Law</u>: The MC must maintain a copy of the motor vehicle record (MVR) received from each State in the driver qualification file.

<u>Supporting documents</u>: This violation took place during the transportation described in Count One, above. The MC was unable to provide MVRs for the driver involved in this transport.

<u>Violation</u>: The MC failed to maintain the responses of each State agency to the annual MVR inquiry required by 391.25(a) (**Exhibit 1, Page 3**). Two (2) violations were discovered.

Recommendation: Staff recommends an enhanced violation of \$500, due to the same violation being discovered in the previous compliance investigation conducted on July 19th, 2021. A Penalty Order was issued penalizing the Carrier for this violation in Docket No. 22-TRAM-048-PEN on August 10, 2021.

RECOMMENDATION:

Transportation Staff recommends the Commission find Tanner Moore committed three (3) violations accounting for two (2) specific counts of Kansas law that governs MCs, including various provisions of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs), as adopted by the Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.s), and is therefore subject to sanctions or fines imposed by the Commission.

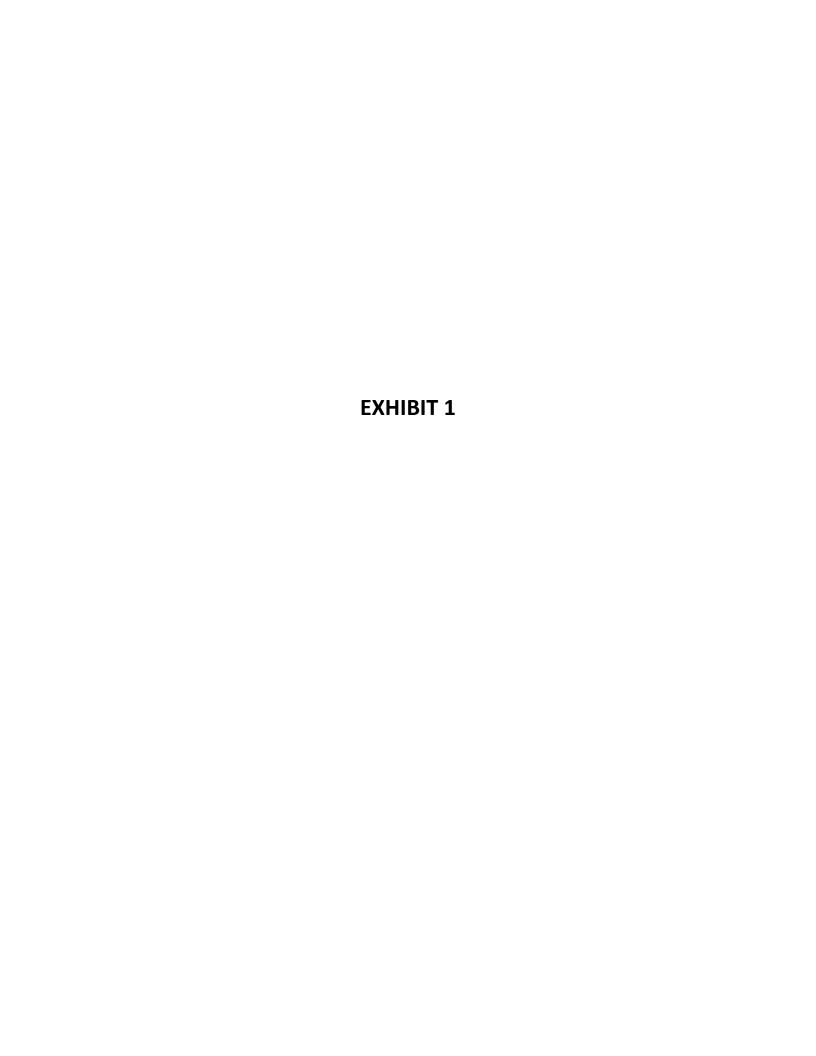
Due to the frequency, timeline and severity of the violations, Staff recommends a civil penalty of \$1,250 for three (3) violations of the MC Safety Statutes, Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the recommended penalties listed in the applicable Uniform Penalty Assessment Matrix.

Staff further recommends Tanner Moore require a representative responsible for the company's safety to attend a Commission-sponsored safety seminar within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order, and provide Litigation Counsel with written proof of attendance. A schedule

of the dates and locations for safety seminars can be found on the Commission's website at http://kcc.ks.gov/trans/safety_meetings.htm.

Staff further recommends Tanner Moore submit a written, comprehensive Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to Transportation Staff within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, documenting the violation(s) described in the Penalty Order, including specific and detailed information explaining the carrier's efforts and concrete steps taken to ensure the violation(s) do not occur in the future.

Finally, Staff recommends that Tanner Moore submit to one follow-up safety compliance review within eighteen (18) months from the date of the Penalty Order. Transportation Staff will contact the motor carrier at a later date to determine an appropriate time for the review.

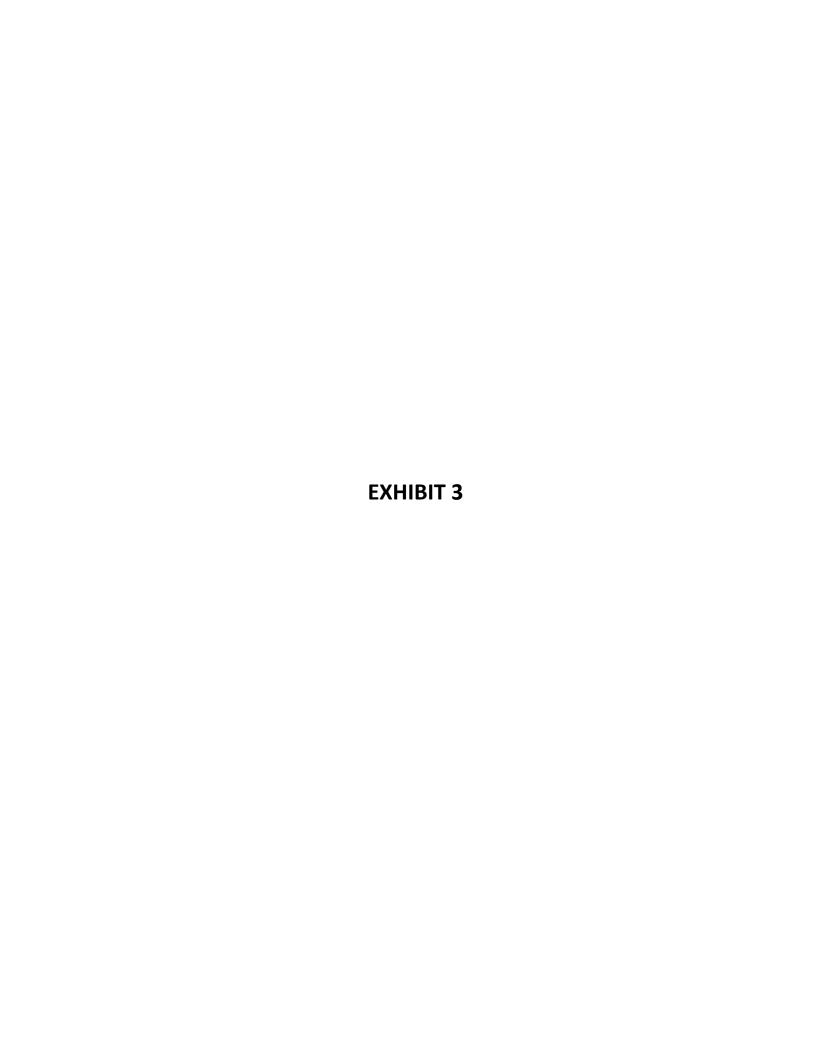


